### *"Attempts for Ground Incursion into Khan Al- Sheih amid Aerial Bombardment"*



- The death of one Palestinian in Yarmouk due to siege and lack of health care.
- Mortars target the outskirts of Al Sayeda -Zeinab camp.
- Arresting number of Palestinians from Khan Al-Sheih.
- Syrian security releases one of Palestinian National civil commission figures' and another Palestinian from Neirab.
- UNRWA pays for ATM cards for PRS in Lebanon.

### **Victims**

*"Mohammed Khaled", Palestinian refugee from Al Rejah was killed as a result of siege and lack of health care which increases the number of victims who were killed by the same reason to (190).*

*Dr. Reyad Idrees, the director of Medical Rescue Center in Yarmouk, had described the healthy and humanitarian situation in the trapped areas of Yarmouk as tragic. A lot of disease were diffused Inflammatory bowel and Gastritis were the most common ones in addition to Typhoid fever and Inflammation of the upper respiratory tract.*



*It's worth mentioning that ISIS Imposes a blockade on Al-Rejah and its surroundings, Ain Ghazal and Haifa St. in Yarmouk after closing the only barrier that joined the area of "Jabhat Fateh al-Sham". In addition, it prevents the citizens from entering or leaving the region. Moreover, delivering foodstuffs was also forbidden except for rare conditions, in order to force the rest of Jabhat Fateh al-Sham members to surrender or to leave.*

*Syrian regime continued imposing its siege over several areas and the camp for (1213) consecutive days. Power was cut for more than (1274) days in addition to water cut for (764) days respectively.*



### ***Recent Updates***

*AGPS reporter said that the most violent fierce clashes were held in Khan Al-Sheih's outskirts between Syrian regime and armed opposition parties amid regime's attempts for military ground incursion to control the area.*

*In the same time, Russian and Syrian aircrafts were shelling the eastern farms in western Ghouta by a number of airstrikes.*

*According to the humanitarian conditions, residents of Khan Al-Sheih have been suffering from a tight siege included all the camp for 12 consecutive days which leads to lack of foodstuffs like bread, medicine and infants' milk.*



*A lot of activists demanded to launch campaigns all over Europe in solidarity with Khan Al-Sheih to stop targeting it, lift the siege and provide it with all kinds of aids.*

*Reportedly, in Damascus countryside AGPS was reported about shelling the outskirts of Al Sayeda -Zeinab camp with 4 mortars causing massive destruction and widespread panic.*



*It's worth mentioning that Al Sayeda -Zeinab had witnessed a lot of bombings that targeted pro-Syrian regime groups causing dozens of Palestinian victims from the camp. AGPS has also documented 61 victims from the same camp were killed since the beginning of war in Syria.*



*In the meantime, the members of the pro- Syrian regime Zaita barrier in zakia have arrested two Palestinian refugees. The college student " Ahmad Haider Ali " and the refugee " Abu Saddam Heji" on Wednesday without any justified reason.*

*It's important to remember that (109) Palestinian refugees are under the arrest of Syrian regime, according to AGPS documented statistics.*

*In a related context, Syrian security forces release the Palestinian refugee " Mohammed Qasem , Abu Khaled" one of Palestinian National civil commission figures'. He was arrested by security members on Beit Sahem barrier two months ago.*

*Abu Khaled was volunteering for the commission; he was facilitating the movement of Yarmouk's students. It's important to know that Palestinian National civil commission was an initiative from Yarmouk residents with*





*the approval of Palestinian parties to manage the camp. Unfortunately, a number of its members were killed in the war or arrested by Syrian security forces.*

*Moreover, Syrian security has released the Palestinian refugee " Nidal Isa Al Naji" (52) years after 10 days of arrest. He was captured by one of regime barriers in his way to Nierab camp after a surgical operation in Aleppo.*

*In the same time, Syrian security forces still hiding the truth about the fate of more than (1100) Palestinian refugees in its prisons. Among those detainees were women, children, elderly, brothers, fathers, whole families and hundreds of them were killed because of torturing.*

*UNRWA has paid for ATM cards for displaced Palestinian-Syrians in Lebanon. 100\$ was paid for rent for each displaced Palestinian family from Syria and 40,000 LL (nearly 27\$ for each person) for food for September and October.*

*It's also worth mentioning that UNRWA managed to send messages to PRS reporting them about an exceptional postponing September's and October's financial dues payment to the middle of October because of the renewal of ATM cards. In the beginning of this month (October) UNRWA has fulfilled its promise and renewed the cards and handed them to PRS families.*

*Luckily, UNRWA has managed through its urgent appeal for Syria in 2016 to keep providing Palestinian refugees, who escape from Syria to Lebanon, with money as the following:*



40,000 LL per person for food till the end of 2016 and 100\$ for rent every month starting from March to October 2016.

### ***Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 13/10/2016***

- (15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.
- (42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.
- (6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.
- (8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.
- (1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.
- More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.
- Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1213) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1274) days. water was cut for (764) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (188).
- Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1066) days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about (1258) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Daraa Camp: - It is now almost (916) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
