VICTIMS

"Ra'fat Nayif Mohammad Shihada" 20-years-old, a personnel of Palestinian Liberation Army PLA was killed in pro-regime clashes in Damascus Suburb.

turning deaf ears to the calls of activists and civil society organizations refugees' families that refuse that decision.


The Palestinian-Syrian refugee "Haitham Hayil Saleh" from Al-Sayyida Zaynab camp was killed in clashes as he's member of pro-regime militias, and his funeral was held in his camp this morning.

It is noteworthy that the pro-regime militias recruit many of the Palestinian-Syrians for money; taking advantage of the miserable conditions they live in their camps of unemployment and poverty to push them towards battlefronts.

RECENT UPDATES

During its participation in a conference concerning the refugees issue held by Science Faculty of Istanbul University; the "Turkish Organization in solidarity with Palestine FIDDER" demanded to allow the Palestinian-Syrians to enter Turkey legally the same like their fellow Syrian refugees, this came on the lips of its director "Mohammad Mushienish" who highlighted the suffering of the Palestinian-Syrians while his speaking

about the historical context of the Palestinian refugees case since 1948's Nakba.



Mr. Mushienish also mentioned the international laws pertaining to refugees issue explaining how injustice it was in regards of their long term sufferings, refusing to limit their issue into food and daily needs.

It is noteworthy that the approximate number of Palestinian-Syrians in Turkey, according to unofficial census, estimated at 6000-8000 refugees and distributed in Turkish province as follows: 69% of refugees live in Southern provinces like Mersin, Kilis, Hatay, Rehanli, and Orfa, while 24% live in Istanbul and 5% live in other provinces as mentioned in the AGPS' last semi-annual report in August 2015.

In a different context, the Syrian Security has released the Palestinian refugee "Mohammad Fuad Al-Darbi" from Al-Nayrab camp after arresting him for a week.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS has documented

1018 cases of arrest and enforced

disappearance related to Palestinian-Syrians in Syria.

CIVIL SOCIETY WORKS

The "Palestine Charity Organization" continues providing its relief services to the displaced families of Yarmouk camp in the nearby towns, according to the organization; its pharmacy has dispensed more than 1076 prescriptions for free during the last month only, while its medical staff continues offering treatment for burns and emergency cases.

It is worth mentioning that "Palestine Charity Organization" and dozens of activists and hundreds of families were obliged to leave Yarmouk camp towards the nearby towns after ISIS' break into the camp last April.

In Aleppo, the Palestinian Red Crescent and the "The Charity Organization to Relief the People of Palestine" distributed relief aid to the residents of Al-Nayrab camp included food baskets and winter clothes.

It is important to mention that Al-Nayrab camp is still under the control of Syrian Regime and its militias.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 13 December 2015

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 895 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 965 days, water cut for 455 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 756 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 957 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Water cut continues for 601 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Homs and Aedein Hamma: A relatively quiet situations in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
