
"Yarmouk Residents and Bodies Assure Staying in Yarmouk and Stress on the Political Solution for their Suffering"

Victims

The Palestinian refugee "Mohammed Al Sabbagh" and his wife died due to a previous shelling that targeted the Yarmouk Camp, while their bodied were found at their house behind Palestine hospital.

Meanwhile, the female Palestinian refugee "Mahdeia Ouda Habeib," was born in 1942 also died due to shrapnel by the Syrian warplanes shelling at Daraa Camp.

Recent Updates

Sporadic clashes broke out yesterday between ISIS groups and AKnaf brigades, which centered in the vicinity of Yarmouk Girls High School area in Martyr Jalal Kawash Street near Palestine Street, Yarmouk Street, and Loubia street while 80% of the camp is still under the control of ISIS.

For their part, residents, organizations, and institutions in the Yarmouk refugee camp protested yesterday in front of the youth center in schools Street in Yarmouk, where they demanded the UN and the PLO to work to solve the tragedy of Yarmouk politically not military. In addition, they assured people's needs of food and medicine, and emphasized their stay

in camp, and their rejection of any safe passage out of the Yarmouk unless it ensures their return to Palestine.

On the other hand, the Syrian authorities close the road toQudsaya area in the Damascus suburb, after a group of Syrian armed opposition kidnapped a member of Syrian security forces who entered the area by mistake.

It is noteworthy that nearly 6,000 thousands of Palestinian families have resorted to this area after their displacement from the Yarmouk refugee camp and other camps because of the crisis in their areas three years ago. The region is witnessing an unstable state due to the deterioration of the security situation between now and then.

Those families are suffering of dire living situation as a result of high prices and unemployment, as well as the absence of income for most of these families who were forced to rent houses at high prices due to their economic and financial crisis over their plight and the loss of their homes and property in the Palestinian camps.

Solidarity Sit-ins with the Yarmouk Camp

Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and Palestinian workers League Participated in a solidarity vigil with Yarmouk Camp that was held yesterday, Monday, 13th of April 2015 in front of the UNRWA Services Director Office in the city of Sidon southern Lebanon.


The sit-in included banners of solidarity with the Palestinian people in the camps in Syria and the refugee camp of Yarmouk, statement by the People's Committees of the Alliance of Palestinian forces in the city of Sidon, and the number of speeches which called all parties to neutralize the Palestinian refugee camps in Syria.

Protestors demanded to stop the bloodshed in Yarmouk, to end the siege, and to open safe humanitarian corridors to enter the medical and food aid immediately.

In the end of the sit-in, Director of UNRWA Services Office in the city of Sidon received a memorandum from the members of the People's Committees of the Alliance of Palestinian Forces.

Italy

Italian Coastguard announced on Monday that at least nine people have died after an overcrowded migrants' boat drawn off the coast of Libya, while 144 other people were rescued after intensive naval efforts in the region. The nationalities of the victims were not announced, while number of activists launched distress calls earlier where the boat was carrying a number of Palestinian and Syrian refugees.

Sweden

The first consultative meeting of Palestinians of Syria in Sweden was held yesterday in the city of Hlsnbura. The meeting was attended by "Mohammed Abu Hija," a representative of the Palestinian Center for Justice, "Ala AL Got," a representative of the Ibn Rushd Foundation, and

number of Palestinian refugees of Syria who inhabit the cities of, "Autobra," "Malmo," "Landskrona," "Hlsnbura" and its surroundings.

During the meeting, it was announce the launch of the Palestinians of Syria Commission in Sweden "continue" which operates under the umbrella of the Palestinian Center for Justice Malmo. The attendance also agrees to leave the drafting of a letter from the Palestinians of Syria in Sweden to the Palestinians of Europe Conference which will take place on 25th of April 2015. They also agreed upon sequential series of meetings in the future, work for Palestinian refugees in Syria, and to provide facilities for the newcomers Palestinians to Sweden.

Civil Work Committees

Jafra Foundation and Nour Association for Relief and Development managed to introduce new quantities of relief materials to the regions of Yalda and Beit Sahem in order to be distributed to the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp who are displaced to those regions as a result of ISIS breaking into the camp since the beginning of April, as well as the shelling and the violent clashes between Aknaf and ISIS alongside Al Nusra Front.

Numbers and Statistics till 134/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 646 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 726 days, water was cut for 216 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 175 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 547days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 517days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 719 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 363days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
