Victims

Palestinian child Emad Jihad Diab died on Monday, February 13, after artillery shells hit AlMuzeireeb town, to the northwest of Deraa city.

Palestinian refugee Mohamed Dib AlAyedi succumbed to the wounds he sustained after a shell slammed into Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees, in southern Damascus.



Latest Developments

Palestinian refugee from Syria Abdul Rahman Mohamed Mohamed Abdul Rahman, died on February 13 after he fell from the fifth floor of a building under construction in AlSafsaf neighborhood, in Ein AlHilweh Camp, in the southern Lebanese city of Sidon.

The Human Appeal NGO attributed the death to skull fractures and cerebral lacerations inflicted by the accident.

Abdul Rahman, aged 36, was a resident of Yarmouk Camp in war-torn Syria. He fled to Lebanon in the hunt for a safer shelter.



In another development, the Development Committee in Latakia-based AlRaml Camp distributed on Monday, February 13, 2017, winter clothes to schoolchildren and kids sheltered in the area.

On February 14, the Palestinian Cultural Center delivered food parcels donated by the Islamic Relief Organization to displaced Palestinian families from Syria in Saad Nayel area, in Lebanon's Central Bekaa.

Up to 850 Palestinian families from Syria are taking refuge in the Lebanese Bekaa Valley, according to recent statistics.



Meanwhile, AGPS launched a so-codenamed "You Report" mobile phone application that will enable users to report violations and developments as regards the Palestinians of Syria far and wide.

Earlier, AGPS launched an application enabling subscribers to access daily reports and pieces of news on the situation of the Palestinians of Syria.



The application also provides extensive material and fact-based studies and statistics on the casualties, detainees, and missing Palestinians in Syria.

Palestinians of Syria: February 14, 2017 Statistics:

- *At least 3,441 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.*
- *1,164 Palestinian refugees, including 83 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.*
- *Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine - General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,335 days in a row.*
- *190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.*
- *Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,039 and 846 days.*
- *Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,383 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 118 days.*

- *Government troops ban residents of Al-Sbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,188 days running.*
- *Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.*
- *31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.*
- *17 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.*
- *6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.*
- *8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.*
- *1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.*
