### **Recent Updates**

*The Syrian army checkpoints and Public Front General Command groups in Yarmouk camp prevented the refugee Mohammed Zuhair' wife from accompanying her husband, who suffers from internal bleeding and who is allowed to leave for medical treatment outside,. It's worth mentioning that the siege imposed by the regular army and the Public Front General Command roadblocks was the reason behind the killing of 157 Palestinian refugees because of nutrition and medical care shortage.*

*On the other hand, the Palestinian refugee Issa Mazen Ramadan "an element of Al-Quds Brigade and one of Handarat camp residents was killed as a result of the clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army forces. It should be noted that the number of casualties in the camp has reached "37" casualties, including three women, according to the Action Group For Palestinians of Syria documented statistics, which indicate that the victims have been killed as a result of frequent raids and artillery shelling that imposed on the camp. Hanan Abdo and her child were killed out of the raid on September, 9.*

*The clashes between the members of security committees and camp's residents in 28-4-2013 resulted in five Palestinian refugees' victims after the battles that took place between them during the recent problem, while three other people of the camp were killed under torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime.*

*In a related context, the correspondent of the "Action Group" delivered news about injuring of two members of the Al-Quds Brigade, namely*



*Mohammed Abu Harsh from Al Nairab camp and Mahmoud Kasem from Handarat camp, during clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army backed National Defense and the Palestinian al-Quds Brigade troops.*



#### ***Issa Mazen Ramadan Funeral***

*In Aleppo, The electricity returned to al-Neirab camp after outage lasted for about two years, but the camp's residents have complained about the lack of regularity of the electricity also they are imposed to interruption again due to overloading the power grid.*

*While the electricity network maintenance workers said that the real reason behind the continuation of a power outage is the big damage in the thermal station which supplies the camp and surrounding areas.*

*He added, "Today we face problem of great pressure on the power network because of the use of the electric heaters, which will result inevitably large faults in the network, accordingly will caused a power cuts" . It is noteworthy that the power supply has been cut from the camp since 01/13/2013 prompting its inhabitants to use electricity generators to light their homes and shops which added a new burden on their shoulders.*

*In Damascus, Palestine Authority charity has continued its work in erasing and the deportation of garbage from the Yarmouk refugee camp, in order to lift the debris and trash from the streets of the camp to prevent the spread of epidemics and diseases among the population. So, the service department in Palestine Authority charity has cleaned the sanitation lines in the camp.*

*Meanwhile, they mended the sewer pipes lines to prevent dirty water accumulation, which is causing the spread of odor and germs and diseases among the inhabitants of that region. In the same context, the Committee for the "Palestinians in Syria" in Turkey and the Turkish Association for solidarity with Palestine "Vidar" implemented Heating winter project in the Yarmouk refugee camp provided by the World Assembly of Muslim Youth, where they distributed blankets and firewood to the besieged families in the Yarmouk refugee camp.*

*It is noteworthy that the blockade and scarcity of fuel and its high prices forced the Palestinian refugees in Syria to re-use space heaters firewood, where residents rely on firewood to heat their homes to provide warm for*



*their sons during the winter, especially with frequent interruptions and power cuts for long time.*

*On the other hand, the residents of Alrmdan camp suffers from a real economic crisis caused by the conflict in Syria that caused a prevalence of unemployment and severe shortages of food, medicine, fuel and high prices. It is worth mentioning that Alrmdan camp is of Palestinian refugee camps in Syria, located in the south east of Damascus, a distance of approximately 50 km. The nearest town to the camp is Aldameer city, which is away about 9 km.*

*In Egypt, the Palestinian-Syrian refugees are living under unclear legal situation in conjunction of a political and security tensions in the country. The Egyptian security refuses to give Palestinian-Syrian refugees any stays despite the fact that the requirements for the issuance of those residencies are formal and matches the rules, but “according to our correspondent who met the people”: the Egyptian security’ excuse is “that security clearances have not yet reached” , that is increasing their suffering after the high prices the country witnessed in recent months in addition to the unemployment .*

*These bad circumstances forced hundreds of them to ride boats of death to reach to Europe looking for dignified life and stability, which is lost in Egypt. It’s mentioned that about eight thousand of Palestinian-Syrian refugees came to Egypt during Dr. Mohamed Morsi rule who allowed them to enter Egypt, while now Egypt is currently preventing the entry of Palestinian-Syrian refugees enter into its territory.*

### ***The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 15/12/2014***

- ***The Yarmouk Camp:*** - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for **527** days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than **608** days, water was cut for **97** days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached **157** victims.
- ***Al Husayneyya Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **429** days respectively.



- ***Al Sbeina Camp:*** - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for **399** days respectively.
- ***Handarat Camp:*** - Residents have left the camp for **599** days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- ***Dara'a Camp:*** - It is now almost **244** days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- ***Khan Al Sheih Camp:*** - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- ***Khan Danoun Camp:*** - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- ***Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma:*** - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
