#### **Recent Updates**

Violent explosions rocked the Yarmouk camp yesterday, coincided with warplanes hovering over the camp, while violent clashes broke out yesterday between ISIS groups alongside Al Nusra Front and Aknaf brigades alongside youth of the camp. The clashes broke out at the Yarmouk Municipality crossing, Palestine Street, and Al Rija square, coincided with mortar shelling.

Meanwhile, a child was injured in his leg by sniper shot was centered towards Yelda town at AL Thalathein Street near the sports city in the Yarmouk camp. This comes amid the continuation of ISIS control over the biggest part of the camp.

Moreover, sporadic clashes broke out yesterday in Yarmouk between the PFGC groups and ISIS alongside Al Nusra Front, while uncertain news reported that PFGC groups have advanced towards AL Rija square.

On the other hand, the Syrian army forces and the Syrian security services arrested the female Palestinian refugee "Salam Ammar," 23 years from the besieged Yarmouk camp while trying to leave it through Beit Sahem checkpoint.

It is worth mentioning that the AGPS documented the names of 828 Palestinian refugees who are detained at the Syrian security services; including 23 their fate is unknown yet.

Meanwhile, heavy shelling targeted the adjacent farms of Khan AL Shieh camp by the Syrian warplanes which dropped a number of explosive barrels provoking a state of panic amongst the residents as a result of the explosion sounds. In the meantime, the residents are suffering of dire living situation due to the acute shortage of medical services, the high cost of living, and the difficult transportations from and to the camp.

In Aleppo, a mortar shell targeted the house of the refugee "Nidal Al Khateib" who is displaced from Al Nairab camp to Al Hamdaneia neighborhood in Aleppo. The shelling resulted in significant material damages, with no injuries.

#### Numbers and Statistics till 15/4/2015

- At least 27933 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 647 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 727 days, water was cut for 217 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 175 victims.
- 80,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees escaped from Syria to the neighboring towns, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51,300 in Lebanon and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to UNRWA statistics till February 2015.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 548days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 518days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 718 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 364days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL SaiedaZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
