#### **Hungary**

Rakan Hussein, Palestinian Syrian refugee, continues hunger strike against the obstruction by the Hungarian Government for the procedures of reunion with his 5 children for the third day, respectively.

Rakan Hussein expressed, to our correspondent, obstacles that faced him during his trials to reach Hungary and problems of reunion with his 5 children, saying, "during the reunion procedures, I faced many problems, The first is preventing the entry of my five children, by Lebanon and Jordan, to make interview with the Hungarian embassy, forcing them to gamble their lives by land travelling in order to reach the Turkish crossing border illegally. Turkey also prevents the entry of Palestinian Syrian refugees.

Mr. Rakan Hussein added, "Upon the arrival of my children to Turkey to make the interview with the Hungarian embassy, the embassy conditioned that their entry into Turkey has to be legal and they did not recognize the "Syrian passports" as stipulated by the Hungarian authorities to get another passport for children, and this is very difficult, even passports of the Palestinian Authority take several months.

Rakan continued, "After this suffering, I decided to start hunger strike here from the camp near Budapest, in a protest against the obstacles that faces Syrian Palestinians, and I demand the Hungarian authorities to recognize our passports and allow my children, who are in Turkey, to catch up with me, is it not enough that they have lost their mother! Let them Go"

#### Recent Updates in Syria

Al Nairab Palestinian Refugee camp in Aleppo was exposed to bombings where two shells fallen on its parts and caused material and property damages, amid information about injuries.

In Danoun refugees camp clashes broke up yesterday between groups of Free Army and the Regular Army in the center of Tibal city, coincided with ambulance sounds that carry casualties from the Regular Army.

The clashes and bombings spread a panic state amongst the people of Danoun camp because of the terrible sound of violent bombings. The Danoun camp refugees suffer from the power cut, water cut and telecommunications cut for long periods, moreover, they suffer from the armed groups of checkpoints who bother the camp refugees and confiscate their things.

In the last few days, the Danoun camp witnessed a number of arrests amongst its residents from the armed groups of the Danoun camp Checkpoint.

A calm state spread out in the Yarmouk camp and people still refuse to receive the food aid protesting against the degrading, mistreatment and humiliation by the Syrian Security Forces during the distribution of aids, according to a statement issued by the Yarmouk camp residents.

In Khan Al Sheih refugee camp electricity returned back after it was cut for sixteen hours.
