"Syrian Security Services Continue Arresting Palestinian Medical Cadres in Charges of Helping Injuries"

Recent Updates

Syrian security forces continue to arrest a group of Palestinian medical staff and keep reticent about their fate, as a number of them died due to torture in its jails under the pretext of providing medical and humanitarian work for the people of the camp and the wounded from neighboring areas.

The Action Group for Palestinians of Syria documented earlier the arrest of each of:

Doctor Hayel Qasim Hameid, 67 years, a doctor in general surgery, and a professor at the Faculty of Human Medicine at the University of Damascus, served as general surgery department at al-Assad University Hospital, and he was arrested by the Syrian regime forces after a raid on his clinic in the Yarmouk refugee camp on 08/13/2012 charges of treating wounded people.

Doctor Aladdin Yousef, 62 years, a neurological surgery doctor at Yarmouk camp and was arrested from a checkpoint at the entrance of Yarmouk camp on 12/25/2012.

In addition to the doctor, Malik Mohammad Yousef, a graduate of Dentistry, Surgery Master "fourth year" and was arrested by the Syrian regime forces from Damascus University - Faculty of Dentistry on 23.05.2013.

The medical staff and institutions in the Yarmouk refugee camp were exposed to serious violations by the Syrian army and security, bombing of



hospitals and targeting of ambulances sometimes, and arresting and killing medical staff at other times.

These violations have claimed the lives of dozens of paramedics, nurses, and specialists, while the Syrian security services refuse revealing the fate of the detained Palestinians and their numbers in its jails,

The AGPS documented 922 detainees including 406 have died due to torture in Syrian prisons.

On the other hand heavy shelling, targeted the adjacent areas and farms of Khan Al Shieh camp on Tuesday night, coincided with clashes between the Syrian armed opposition forces, and the regime forces backed by the civil Committees at all conflict axes near the camp, triggering panic and tension among residents for fear of being bombed.

Large displacements towards Zakia town at Alderkhbayh town and homes scattered in the vicinity of Khan Zakya territory adjacent to Khan Al Shieh camp, to escape the indiscriminate shelling that targeted the region and the sniper who targeted the Alderkhbayh checkpoint.



Residents of Khan AL Shieh camp complain of serious humanitarian crises as a result of the military confrontations escalation between the free army groups and the regular army in the surrounding areas, making it in the middle of bloody overheating conflict in Syria, which had a negative impact on the population in terms of the continued closure of all roads inking between the camp and adjacent regions except Zakia– Khan Al Shieh road.

People are forced to go through the only way despite the risks they face following clashes between the regular army and groups of free army between now and then.

Meanwhile, closing the only road linking to the camp by the regular army and tightening their security procedures has affected negatively on the availability of the necessary food supplies in the camp, where any varieties of food supplies were lost and prices of other species were increased.

In the northwest of Syria, people of Al Raml camp in Latakia are complaining of continued raids and arrests campaigns carried out by the



Syrian security services between now and then to the homes of the camp and increase the suffering of the population.

Pro-Syrian regime Palestinian groups raided their homes and control some of them to take as headquarters, as youth suffers from Syrian security services prosecution for the PLA obligatory service, while many of them were forced to escape out of the country.

Residents of Al Raml camp live in a state of calm amid the continuing economic suffering, where they are complaining of high Prices of food supplies, in addition to the high cost of rented homes.

Statistics

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team announced that it documented the names of 55 Palestinian refugees who died out side Syria, including 15 refugees in Egypt, 6 refugees in Malta, 8 refugees in Greece, 8 refugees in Lebanon, 5 refugees in Turkey, 3 refugees in Palestine, 3 refugees in Italy, 4 refugees in Libya, a refugee in Sweden, a refugee in Cyprus, and a refugee in Macedonia.

It was mentioned that the number of Palestinian refugees who died until the end of June 2015 is 2910 Palestinian victims, according to the AGPS documented statistics, where victims died due to direct reasons such as shelling, clashes, torture in detention centers, bombings, and blockade, and indirect reasons such as drowning while trying to reach Europe and through what has become known as the "death boats".



Civil Work Committees

The Delegation of AL Wafaa European campaign carried out field inspection visits in Lebanon to refugees in camps and shelters in the Bekaa central and western areas, following the arrival of the convoy to Lebanon yesterday.

The delegation implemented recreational programs for children in addition to the distribution of food parcels to residents.

The convoy, which includes members of several European countries, announced that that preparation is carried out to enter the Syrian territories and go to Palestinian refugees in the camps and shelters.

It is referred that Al Wafaa European campaign directed several convoys to help Palestinian refugees in Syria and displaced people in the neighboring countries in Lebanon and Turkey.





Numbers and Statistics till 14/7/2015:-

- *80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 747 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 817 days, water was cut for 307 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 628 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 609 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 811 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 454 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
