Victims

Two Palestinians were killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons, they are:

Mahmoud Al Aswad from Al Nairab camp was killed in the Syrian regime prisons after being arrested for more than a year, it is mentioned that his brother "Rajab Al Aswad" was killed four months ago in the same prisons. Maher Omrein, a Palestinian refugee, was also killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.

The death of those refugees raised the documented death toll of the Palestinian victims in the Syrian prisons to 234 victims, it was documented by the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria.

Recent Updates

Amid the continuation of security situation tension, news has been spread among the people of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo about the intention of the Syrian security forces and some Palestinian groups loyal to it to carry out a campaign of arrests, prompting many young people to leave their homes and get out of the camp, but even that some of them have been fled to Turkey.

Thus, the fear of being arrested has been increased, especially because the cascading news about the death of many refugees due to torture in detention at the prisons of the Syrian regime.

Al Nairab camp

It is mentioned that the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria has documented, till today, 234 Palestinian victims who were killed due to torture in the Syrian regime prisons. Meanwhile, the Syrian security forces had arrested the young man, "Safwan Abdul Hamid" from Al Nairab camp several days ago.

On the other hand, the checkpoints of the Popular Front - General Command and the regular army continued to prevent the introduction of food aid to trapped people in the Yarmouk refugee camp for "394" days.

The people of the camp are suffering from difficult living conditions, especially with power full cut over a year ago, in addition to the lack of health services and the stop of all bakeries.

A state of anticipation and instability prevailed in Khan Dannoun camp in Damascus city, particularly in the past few weeks, after the rising of hostilities pace in the regions and towns adjacent to it. The hostilities were between the Syrian opposition forces and the regular army with the participation of some of the camp's residents belonging to the Popular Front- General Command and Fatah Al-Intifada alongside with the regular army. Those hostilities have made the camp subjected to bombardment and the fall of a number of missiles at different places which led to many deaths and injuries.

According to statistics issued by the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria, last month, the number of victims who died from Khan Dannoun

camp because of events in Syria amounted to "12" people. On the other hand, and because of the geographical location of Khan Dannon camp, the regular army has tightened his security grip on the entrances and exits, as it established a checkpoint on the main gate and made the streets a way for its vehicles to the battlefronts with opposition forces in neighboring villages.

On the other hand, the residents of the camp complain about the inhumane treatment of the regular army members, according to the testimonies of many residents to the reporter of the Action Group. Those members confiscated some of their personal belongings and some food supplies which they hold in addition to the random arrests that affect all categories.

In the meantime, it was observed, in the recent period, the prevalence of addiction to alcohol and drug abuse among the people of the camp, prompting the mosque addressers to warn of the danger of this phenomenon and its disastrous results, especially on the camp and the community in general.

In terms of the relief work, the residents are suffering of obvious lack of relief work in light of the difficult economic conditions that they live because of the absence of charity organization or civil work committees inside the camp as a result of security restrictions by the Syrian regime forces and the campaigns of arrest, which affected many of the relief activists.

These actions have prompt these committees to close their doors in order to preserve the lives of activists. The people of the camp, which is considered the poorest among the Palestinian refugee camps in Syria, rely on financial and relief aid provided by UNRWA once in a while.

In terms of living aspect, the residents of the camp complain of acute living crises manifested in food shortage, unemployment, poverty and the continued power, water and telecommunications cut for long periods.

It is noteworthy that Khan Dannon camp was created formally in 1950-1951, the camp is located at a distance of 23 km south of the Syrian capital Damascus, an area of 120,000 square kilometers, with an estimated population of about 12,000 Palestinian refugees, adding to 20,000 people have been displaced from the Yarmouk, Sbeneh, Al saida_Zainab, Khan Al Sheih camps, Al Hussainia compound, Al Thiabeia, AL HAjar Al Aswadand Daria towns because of the security situation deterioration in their areas.

Missing

Contact has been lost with the young man "Qusai Ahmed Musleh", Syrian, from Yarmouk camp, earlier this month after leaving the city of Zuwarah in Libya and there is no information about him till the time of preparing this report.
