Recent Updates

Two mortar shells targeted the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees near the Palestine Hospital in Al Thalathein Street resulted in only material damages. The Yarmouk residents are still suffering from the water cut for the sixth day respectively which increased the residents' suffering in addition to the frequent power cut for more than a year.

The Checkpoints of the Regular Army and the PFGC allowed the entry of a limited quantity of food aids to the camp which is besieged since 421 days. It is referred that the residents are suffering of health and living crises due to the siege and the most prominent is the stop of hospitals, It is mentioned that 155 victims from the Yarmouk residents died due to the shortage of food and medical materials due to the siege





The security tensions in Khan Dannoun camp forced the Palestinian refugees in Damascus city not to send their children to schools especially because of the events in the road that is in Al Taiba village and the road is considered a dangerous road due to the heavy clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition forces in addition to the sniping which exposes the lives of people to dangerous situations. The residents of the camp face huge numbers of displaced people in their schools and the high prices of school stationeries. In terms of living aspect, a calm state prevailed the camp where the economic crises is increasing because of the high prices of food materials and the power and water cut for long hours.



Khan Dannoun camp

In Damascus city, a car that carried Palestinian refugees from Khan Al Sheih camp was exposed to fire shooting on the Zakia road where three refugees were injured due to the shooting on their car. It is mentioned that it is not the first time to target a civilian car in this road. The Zakia road is considered the only road that connects the camp with surrounding areas where it has been closed frequently due to the clashes which resulted in a medical and food material shortage in the camp.

In Turkey, a Palestinian Syrian refugee in the Turkish Kls Shelter Center complains the bad quality of water, and insured that water is undrinkable even after boiling it. He referred to the spread of herpes which is a viral disease with outbreaks of blisters on the skin and it is contagious. It is mentioned that the Palestinian Syrian refugees left to Turkey because of

the clashes, siege and bombardment which threatened their lives in Syria and then they were obliged to enter Turkey by using illegal ways where the Palestinians of Syria should have a Turkish Visa.

On the other hand, Palestinian and Syrian refugees who are on a boat in front of the Italian coast launched appeals because their boat is threatened to sink in any moment and it contains 200 immigrants including women and children. The Action Group received news about that all boats that carry Syrian and Palestinians of Syria refugees are all in good health, it is referred that the boat left Libya to Italy yesterday and the passengers now are on an Italian battleship.

Civil Work Committees

The Palestine Charity Commission for the relief of Palestinian People in Al Aedin camp in Hama distributed school stationeries on more than a hundred students from the camp residents.
