Victims

The Lieutenant Yousif Qassab Jom'a from the PLA died due to a wound he attained during clashes between the Syrian Army alongside the PLA against the Opposition groups in Tal Kurdi Damascus Suburb.

It is referred that AGPS documented about 147 victims from the PLA died due to clashes with the Opposition forces in several areas in Syria since the beginning of the war.

The Palestinian refugee Mohammed Al Sabroji 30 years from Al Muzareeb compound south of Daraa died due to fire shooting at Al Muzareeb.

Recent Updates

On September 11, A group affiliated on the Syrian opposition in Khan Al-Sheeh camp in Damascus suburb calling itself "Al-Fatheen Brigade", abducted two residents of Khan Al-Sheeh camp, Mahmoud Al-Ramlee,

and "Thabet Fa'or" during their departure from Friday prayer in which they were accused of dealing with the Syrian regime. According to the correspondent of Al- Amal group from the camp, he stated that the members of Al- Fateheen Brigade and two days after the kidnapping of two young men, they had released Mahmoud Al- Ramlee and thrown him on a street in the camp in which he

was in a state of extreme fatigue as a result of the severe torture in which he endured. These members told the relatives of "Thabet Fa'or", Syrian citizen from the Golan, the news of his death of a heart attack due to torture.

Turning to the south of Syria, an armed group released the manager of the southern region of the Relief and Works Agency for Palestine Refugees "UNRWA", Gamal Zwaawi" (57 years), one of the residents of Al-Muzeireeb compound after he was kidnapped on September 11, 2015, while returning from his work in the town of Dael to Al-Muzeireeb town, noting that Al-Zawawi is an English language teacher.

It is mentioned that Zawawi did not give any information about the reason beyond his abduction or the demands of the kidnappers and their treatment, he said: "his abduction is a message by armed groups for some of the workers in the southern region". In the same context, the Syrian security released the elderly "Om Al- Abed Fares" from the residents of Al- Aadeen camp in Hama on the thirteenth of this month after a long arrest for more than fifteen days knowing that she is in the sixth decade of life and from the residents of Al- Shajarah village in Palestine.

On September 9, 2015, the Syrian security forces arrested both of the Palestinian refugees, "Mohamed Orabi," in the third decade of life and from the residents of the city of Acre in Palestine and refugee "Hesham Mohamed Qatoos", in fifth decade of age and a resident of the city of Acre in Palestine, while traveling to Turkey through the city of Hama.

While the rest of the residents of the Yarmouk camp are still suffering from the continued water cuts all around the camp since (364) days forcing them to pull the non-potable water from wells and bring drinking water from the only point which was pumping water in Al-Orooba Street.



After a stop for nearly two months, the residents began to bring drinking water from Al- Qadam area nearby the camp but its blockade by ISIS, caused a real crisis that threatens to increase the spread of diseases and epidemics with the lack of medical supplies and medicines.

The Yarmouk camp witnessed yesterday the exit of group of students trapped inside it who are successful in high school diploma to be accepted in the academic year 2015 – 2016. The General Authority for Palestinian Arab Refugees assumed responsibility for student output and bring them back to the camp.


On the other hand, the Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian people provided infant milk to the residents of the Yarmouk camp who are displaced in the regions of Yalda and Babbila in which the commission limited the days of distribution on Sundays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays according to lists prepared by the Charity Commission previously.



In a different context, hundreds of Palestinian refugees, who escape from the Syrian war, are continuing the journey of migration towards European countries especially the asylum countries. Estimates show that more than 36 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugee arrived in Europe during the last four years. Daily, Palestinian refugees escape from Syria because of tragic circumstances in which they are exposed which forced them to flee from Syria to Turkey and from there to Greece by sea.

In spite of the seriousness of travelling via the sea which caused the death of some of them, it is still the favorite way for migrants due to the appropriate cost and speed access. Then most migrants move overland to Hungary across several countries in an attempt to reach Austria. Some of them are lucky to pass without taking their fingerprints while others are

sent the refugee camps and from Austria, migrants spread in the rest of the European countries of asylum. In contrast of the tragic situation of Palestinians of Syria refugees, the European countries of asylum granted the rights of residence including: studying, housing, education, and financial aid.



Numbers and Statistics till 14/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 804 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 874 days, water was cut for 364 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 180 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 666 days respectively.

- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 867 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 511 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
