#### **Victims**

Palestinian refugee Khaled Mohamed Dhaher, from the pro-government Palestine Liberation Army (PLA), was killed in the raging hostilities with the opposition outfits in Eastern Al-Ghouta.

Khaled's death brings the number of PLA casualties in war-tattered Syria to 197, according to AGPS statistics.



#### Latest Developments

ISIS militias have tightened grip on Al-Rija area in Yarmouk, blocking civilians' access out of and into the area via the ISIS-run Al-Rija checkpoint for the ninth day running.

Recently, ISIS ordered civilians to leave the Fatah Al-Sham-led areas in the shelter within 72 hours following an assault launched by Fatah Al-Sham on the ISIS-controlled checkpoint.

Residents of Yarmouk's western neighborhoods of Al-Rija, Jadat, Ein Ghazal, Street 15, and Al-Thalatheen Street have been grappling with a twofold siege imposed by the government squads and ISIS militias.

Meanwhile, Palestinian refugee Abu Ubeida Al-Khatib, nicknamed the Palestinian, sustained wounds after anonymous gunmen attempted to assassinate him using an explosive device.

The incident occurred in the opposition-run western coastal territory.

Abu Ubeida is an affiliate of the opposition battalions and a resident of Al-Neirab Camp for Palestinian refugees in Aleppo.

Speaking with AGPS, activists attributed the assassination attempt to a live footage posted on Abu Ubeida's Facebook page, in which he accused armed factions of forfeiting Aleppo and throwing in the towel.

In another development, the Palestine Charity Commission, in partnership with the Road to Life Association and KNRP organization, handed out on Saturday in-kind relief items, including heaters, firewood, fuel, orphans' clothes, and blankets, to a number of Palestinian families sheltered in Al-Muzeireeb area, in southern Syria.

At the same time, the Al-Wafaa European Campaign, in cooperation with the Austrian Mercy Foundation, wrapped up the second phase of the socalled "Together for a Warm Winter 5" campaign in the Palestinian refugee camps in Lebanon.

The campaign kicked off in Lebanon in an attempt to assuage the tragic state of affairs endured by the Palestinians of Syria.

AGPS quoted a campaigner as stating that food boxes were distributed to 60 displaced Palestinian families in Al-Abrar Camp, in Bar Elias town.

91 other families sheltered in Burj Al-Barajna and Al-Badawi camps also received food aids and winter blankets.

The campaigners further provided over 60 displaced Palestinians in Baalbek city with fuel supplies.

### Palestinians of Syria: January 15, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,420 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,147 Palestinian refugees, including 81 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.

- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,306 days in a row.
- 190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,010 and 825 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,353 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 88 days.
- Government troops ban residents of Al-Sbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,159 days running.
- Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
