"At Least, 209 Palestinian Children Died in Syria Due to Bombing, Siege, and Torture in the Syrian Prisons"

Recent Updates

AGPS confirmed that it documented the details of killing (209) Palestinian children in Syria, about 6.38% of the victims – 3312 victims- were killed due to the shillings, sniping, siege, and torturing to death in the prisons, according to a survey by AGPS.

As AGPS documentation team mentions in its report (13) that the number of victims (children) maybe more than what is mentioned in the report because of the lack of the specific details about the age of those victims which is predicted to include children.



AGPS daily issues its quarterly report which includes all the detailed statistics on casualties, prisoners, and displaced Palestinians since the outbreak of the war in Syria.

In the western Damascus, warplanes launched a number of air raids targeting Khan-Sheih Palestinian refugees' camp in Damascus and the surrounding farms, led only to material damages.

It is noteworthy that the previous few weeks has witnessed a sharply accelerating escalation in term of the size of the air raids that targeted



Khan Sheih Palestinian refugee camp in Damascus countryside, which resulted in dozens of casualties and wounds from the camp residents and displaced families who escaped the bombing and explosive barrels that targeting the neighboring villages of the camp.

In the south of the capital Damascus, it is reported from the besieged Yarmok camp, that ISIS has evacuated the Arabism street in the besieged Yarmouk refugee camp of its inhabitants claiming that the street and the area are the confrontation point with the opposition forces in Yalda town. ISIS also ordered the families living in the street to go to the neighborhoods of the camp.

On the other side, violent clashes broke out between ISIS- what is known as Islamic army- one of the opposition groups on the edges of the Yalda town beside the camp, where local resources reported that the Islamic Army fighters bombed one of ISIS's sites in the edges of Yalda town, beside –Alhajr alaswd- neighborhood, resulting many victims and wounds of ISIS fighters.

Meanwhile, Alwafiden Camp which is full of Palestinian Families was bombed and targeted by many mortar shells.

It should be noted that the deterioration of the security situation in the areas neighboring Alwafedin camp which is 20 Kilometers far from the Capital Damascus. The camp was targeted from time to time which affected badly on the residents in the camp who are already suffering from poverty, unemployment, and hard-living situation even before the beginning of the war.



Greece

Despite the pain and difficulties of the immigration, a number of Palestinian-Syrian immigrants in cooperation with volunteers from other nationalities in Katsikas Camp , in Greece, established a temporary school for children and adults to learn a set of educational materials and languages such as mathematics, English, Spanish, German and training on the computer, history, and science , volunteers also conducted an exhibition of painting and handicrafts and many activities, in addition to doing school trips for young people outside the camp..

It is noteworthy that the agreements and European laws put thousands of Palestinian and Syrians refugees who fled from Syria with a new and harsh suffering, especially ones are on the Macedonian border and in Greece, where the land borders that lead to EU closed, and the tightening of the Marine guard in the Aegean Sea to prevent the arrival of new immigrants to the Greek islands.





Statistics

84 victims were killed in the second quarter of 2016, where June witnessed the largest number of deaths, as 36 people were killed in this month, where in April, 21 refugees were also killed, while 27 were killed in May..

AGPS documentation team pointed out, 84 of the Palestinian-Syrian refugees were killed in the second quarter of 2016, 33 shot to death, 27 were killed in shillings, 7 were tortured to death, as well as 6 were killed in bombings, 9 were sniped, a victim were killed due to the lack of health care and another was assassinated.

It is noteworthy that the previous statics are the only details that the documentation team of AGPS was able to collect, and the numbers are set to rise due to the tension and the difficulty of moving and communicating there which make the documentation process harder, where families are not allowed to contact with human rights organizations.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 15\08\2016

- *15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan*
- *42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon*
- *6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015*
- *8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey*
- *1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza*



- *More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid 2016*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1155 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1215 days, water was cut for 704 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1007 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - All Residents have left the camp for about 1 198 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 858 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.*
