## Latest Developments

More than 150 civilian families that were displaced from the Yarmouk Basin in the western suburb of Deraa, south of Syria, are facing a homelessness threat once again, due to Tafas town's local council's insistence on getting them out of their shelters in the town's educational schools. Those living in rented shouses are unable to pay their rents once again.

For its part, the local council in Tafas, justified its position that hundreds of students from different age groups will be deprived of this year's educational attainment, because the displaced families are living in a majority of the town's schools, which are about 24 schools for different age groups and student specialties.



At the same time, the displaced families are finding it difficult to find other shelters or homes to live in other than the school, according to one of the displaced people in "Jileen" area. The prices of housing rents are very high, making it difficult to get a house, as well as the lack of financial resources and a breadwinner for the majority of displaced families.

The displaced families have called for humanitarian and relief organizations to act to ease their displacement and secure them against homelessness by finding them suitable accommodation in order to open up space for hundreds of students to complete their education in their schools.

Militants of the ISIS-affiliated “Khaled Ibn Al-Walid” battalion had taken control of the towns of “Tassel”, “Adwan”, “Jileen”, “Sahem Golan” and besieging the town of “Heit” almost completely, causing the displacement of thousands of civilians to neighboring areas.

In the meantime, ISIS in south Damascus targeted who they described as awakening and apostates, with reference to Tahrir Al-Sham in Yarmouk camp with incendiary and explosive bombs.

ISIS published photos showing its targets of a number of civilians’ homes that members of Tahrir Al-Sham use as their center points. Our correspondent pointed out that the target points in the besieged Yarmouk camp lie on the boundary of the Al-Waseem Mosque towards the outskirts of Haifa.



ISIS continues its tightening procedures on the residents of “Rijh” Square and the streets of “Haifa” and “Seforeyya,” west of

Yarmouk camp under the pretext of subordination to the control of Tahrir Al-Sham (previously known as Fath Al-Sham), by continuing to impose a siege on that area and targeting it along with the siege of the Syrian regime forces and its affiliated groups.

Within context of ISIS's practices in south Damascus, it continues its repressive methods and tightening procedures on the residents of Yarmouk camp in Damascus, whether men or women. In addition, it has exaggerated its procedures and ideas to affect the Palestinians in Syria's culture by brainwashing the Palestinian children in Yarmouk camp, through what it calls "Ashbal Al-Khilafah" camps.

According to our correspondent in Yarmouk camp, ISIS is holding its training camps in a number of its schools in the camp. It's exploiting children and cheating on them sometimes with salaries and features and other times through playing on the emotional side of children by manipulating the Shari'a rules to make them agree to the goals of ISIS.

Our correspondent in Yarmouk camp confirmed that ISIS pushed about 150 children into camps that seemed like prisons and prevented them from dealing with their parents and their families, except for short periods of time and under strong supervision.

ISIS trains them to obey the orders of leaders, officers and military personnel, where they are initially trained to listen and obey their parents without hesitation. They finally leave the camp after a certain period of time taking military training and Islamic courses, as tools of systematic killing and destruction.

ISIS also creates live time bombs that are placed on the seam lines and between the public. In the past, these children have been seen in the streets applying the rules put by ISIS.

ISIS has been in control of Yarmouk camp since April 2015, with the help of Tahrir Al-Sham.

### **Local Work Committees**

"Palestinians in Syria Relief and Development Association" has ended its summer clubs for the year 2017. According to the association, more than 160 Palestinians in Syria students attended the clubs in the suburb of Aleppo. They experienced educational and sports activities, cultural competitions, in addition to giving out prizes and financial rewards to the excellent students.

Hundreds of Palestinian-Syrian families had fled to north Syria, fearing the bombardments and sieges on their camps in Syria.

## **Palestinians of Syria: September 15, 2017 Statistics:**

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3578, including 462 women
- 1637 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 103 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,521 days in a row
- 199 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1258 days, and 1097 days in Yarmouk Camp
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo have been banned from their homes for 1,594 days. Government troops have taken over the camp for more than 347 days.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
- 8 thousand refugees are staying in Turkey
- One thousand refugees are present in Gaza
