#### **Victims**

The Palestinian refugee "Ahmad Jihad Saleh" one of Palestinian liberation army figures during the ongoing confrontation between armed opposition groups and Syrian regime in Adra city in Damuscus countryside.



According to AGPS statistics, the number of Palestinian liberation army victims has reached 188 and 21 of them were killed in September.

It worth mentioning that Palestinian refugees in Syria are obliged to join the military services for the Palestinian liberation army and whoever disobeys its orders will be arrested. Many of its soldiers had defected it joining the opposition groups against the Syrian regime.

### **Recent Updates**



The 302 commission to defend refugee's rights condemns targeting the camp causing a number of victims and massive destruction in houses, hospitals, civil institutions and infrastructure.



It demanded in its statement, which AGPS had received a copy from it, the Syrian regime to stop targeting the camp and its infrastructure immediately, lift the siege and to provide the camp with medicines and infants' milk.

The statement refers to the necessity of expanding UNRWA's operations to include the physical protection in addition to the legal and humanitarian ones. Moreover, it calls for private protection for UNRWA's institutions and employees and to facilitate their movement in the camp.

At the end of its statement, it called all the interested parties and international ones to provide Palestinian refugees in Syria with full protection till their return to Palestine.

In the meantime, a video of suicidal attempt for Palestinian young man in Vienna was being widely shared on Facebook. His decision had come

because of his fear and worry about the situation of his family in Khan Al-Sheih especially after the heavy and continuous shelling using international prohibited bombs on the camp in the last weeks.



It's important to mention that that young man was shocked when he saw the video of his father's death in the camp by a Russian raid two months ago.

In the south of Damascus, the Sheikh of Abd al-Qadir al-Husayni mosque took a shot in his shoulder by a sniper in front of the mosque, which is considered a battleground between ISIS and Jabhet Fatah Al-Sham.

In the same time, ISIS still imposes its siege over the areas that are under the control of Jabhet Fatah Al- Sham to enforce Al- Sham members to surrender. Unfortunately, they refused to do so while there is some news about a deal with Syrian regime to facilitate their withdrawal to Idlib as what had happened with Qudsya and Al Hama.

In different context, Syrian security releases "Abu Saddam Heji" after two days of arrest. He was captured without justified reasons with the college student "Ahmad Haider Ali" on 13 October 2016 by Zaite barrier members' in Zakia.

Turing to Lebanon, the Palestinian- Syrian child "Mariam Arjawe" from Khan Al- Sheih died because of car accident near Jalil camp in Baalbek.

It was the second time that Palestinian

— Syrian children in Lebanon exposed to car accidents in less than a week. Some activists launched a call for help two days ago to rescue the life of a 12-year Palestinian child "Mahmoud Omar al Hendi", who was hit by a car while he was passing through Sea Cornice St. He was transferred to Labib Hospital by the Lebanese Red Cross and he is now between life and death.



#### Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 15/10/2016

- (15500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan.
- (42,500) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon.
- (6000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015.

- (8000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey.
- (1000) Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza.
- More than (79,000) Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid-2016.
- Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regime's Army and PFGC groups, continued for (1215) consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than (1276) days. water was cut for (766) days respectively. The number of siege victims is (190).
- Sabina Camp: Regime's Army is still forbidding the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for (1068) days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about (1260) days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Daraa Camp: It is now almost (918) days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were totally destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL Sayeda -Zeinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
