"Activists Broadcast a Video of Refugees from the Yarmouk Camp Assassination by Al Nosra Front"



- Clashes and shelling target the Yarmouk camp.
- Thousands of Palestinian families at Qudseia area in Damascus suburb are suffering of hard living conditions.
- 17 victims from Al Raml camp at Lathakeia were killed due to the ongoing war in Syria.
- Al Zeir: the Palestinians of Syria have been left to their destiny to face their renewable Nakba.
- Palestinians of Syria at Greece continue their sit-in till they achieve their demands.
- Malaysian Immigration Police continue to arrest the Palestinian refugee "Abdullah Khattab".

Recent Updates

A number of activists shared a video shows members of Al Nusra Front implementing, described by one of them as, "the first application of Hadd punishment to someone who had Sacrilege of the God". Therefore, Al Nusra Front execute all of "Mari Al Madani" cleavage First Sergeant of PLA, and "Muhammad Abu Siam, "a resident of the Yarmouk refugee camp on Wednesday last.

This act had a wave of disapproval and rejection of the people in the Yarmouk refugee camp, where they found it a new kind of dictatorship, while others questioned the eligibility of" Al Nusra "in the issuance of those provisions and implementation.

In a related context, bombing with several shells targeted several areas in the Yarmouk camp, coincided with the sound of clashes that broke out in the vicinity of the camp, and states that the camp is subject to the siege imposed by the regular army and groups of the Popular Front - General Command, which resulted in the death of "157" refugees so far.

In Damascus suburb, about 6 thousand displaced Palestinian families from the Palestinian refugee camps, especially the Yarmouk refugee camp, living in Qudsaya area in Damascus suburb, are suffering of harsh living situations and conditions as a result of high prices and unemployment and also because of the lack of income for most of these families who were forced to rent houses with high prices what caused them economic and financial crisis over their plight and the loss of their homes and property in the Palestinian camps.

On the other hand, the documentation team of the AGPS revealed that the number of victims from Al Raml camp in Latakia, since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached "17" victims, including "10" died due to torture, while Two refugees were shot by a sniper, Two refugees were killed by gunshot, while another two refugees were kidnapped and then killed, and one refugee died due to a health crisis.

For his part, "Majid Al-Zeer", member of the AGPS, confirmed that the Palestinian refugees from Syria have been abandoned to face their fate and their renewable Nakba, indicating that it does not negate the effort that has been exerted to their advantage here and there. "Zeer" considered that everybody is Shortened without exception, with varying responsibility by influence and potential, he added, during his participation in the "news stations" program on Jerusalem satellite Channel that there is still what can be provided by the Palestinian people to our people from the Palestinians of Syria whether inside Syria or abroad, blaming responsibility to the PLO, the Palestinian Authority, the factions, civil society institutions, personalities and anyone has function on any kind of tender, noting that the file supposed to be outside the scope of conflict and score points.

On the other hand, a number of Syrian and Palestinian Syrian refugees continue their sit-in in the Greek city of Athena protesting against the tightening of security procedures on them and not allowing them to leave Greece to the rest of the European countries.

According to a statement of one of the protesters that an official of Greek Ministry of Interior asked the protesters to break up the sit-in and to evacuate the squares, but the protesters refused and demanded of the Interior official to listen to their demands, and in turn, Deputy Minister of the Greek state for immigration and passports agreed to meet a delegation of Palestinians of Syria and asked them to make a list of the names of the protesters and brought with them.

It should be noted that Greece is one of the main gates of the arrival of refugees fleeing from the ongoing war in Syria to Europe in search of security, but the tightening of Greek security procedures towards refugees prevented the arrival of hundreds of them to their destination which led to hold them to stay in Greece at their own expense.

In a related context, Malaysian immigration police continues to arrest the Palestinian refugee "Abdullah's Khattab" on 11/16/2014, and states that dozens of Palestinian Syrian refugees suffer from the difficulty of obtaining legal residency in Malaysia due to the tightening of the Malaysian laws relating to residencies making most of them vulnerable to detention by the authorities there.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 15/12/2014

• The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 528 days respectively. In addition, power cuts

continued for more than 609 days, water was cut for 98 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.

- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 430days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 400 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 600 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 245 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: Power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Ca mps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
