Victims

The Palestinian refugee "Saleim Bishtawi" from the Yarmouk Camp and a member of a pro-Syrian regime armed groups died during clashes with Al Nusra Front in the vicinity of Yarmouk high school for girls, while militants of Nusra withdraw his body inside their controlled areas in the camp.

Recent Updates

Five wounded at least including a mother and three children were injured by rocket fire and mortar shells that targeted Khan AL Shieh camp in Damascus suburb yesterday.

The shelling was concentrated at vegetable market area at AL Madares Street and Al Khawalda lane, and resulted inconsiderable material damage.

The AGPS correspondent reported that a 10-year-girl was among the injured, while the medical staff was forced to amputate her leg because of her severe injury and the lack of medical and emergency supplies.

In the south of the Syrian capital Damascus, helicopters dropped a number of explosive barrels on the Yarmouk refugee camp, resulting in a number of injuries among civilians, as well as considerable material damage at homes and property.

Meanwhile, the regular army while bombed Ein Ghazal areas with two heavy rockets of in the middle of the last night with no injuries, followed by violent clashes with various types of weapons on several conflict axes (Rija Square - Yarmouk high school for Girls –Al Tadamon).

The clashes broke out between Al-Nusra Front alongside ISIS and Ahrar-Sham on one hand and regular army, who withdrew of several points were stationed in.

At Aleppo, it was recently noticed that the number of Palestinian families who left Al Nairab camp to Turkey in order to migrate illegally to European countries due to the deteriorated living and security situation and because the Syrian security forces and the affiliated groups such as AL Quds brigade are chasing the Palestinian youth and force them to join the PLA.

In addition to imposing strict security procedures on the youth movements in and outside the camp, as well as the Syrian Security arrested many of them.

On the other hand, Syrian regime forces arrested the Palestinian young man Mahmoud Azeema on Bait Sahem checkpoint while he was getting out of Yarmouk camp though he had a permit from the Syrian Security and the Palestine ambassador to get out for treatment.

It is referred that it was not the first case to arrest Palestinian refugees on the checkpoints of the camp and the entrances leading to it despite the permits that they had from the Syrian security which is delivered to the Palestine embassy.

The Syrian Security released the Palestinian refugee female Amal Asfour after being arrested for 15 days; she is an activist at the Palestinian National Organization at the Yarmouk camp.

It is referred that the AGPS documented about 50 Palestinian detained refugees at the Syrian prisons and their destiny is still unknown.

Lebanon

In light of escalating their protests against the UNRWA decisions to reduce the financial aids to the Palestinian refugees, dozens of camps' residents of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon carried out a protest in front of the office of UNRWA's Head at Tire city south of Lebanon.

The protestors condemned the latest decisions of UNRWA that provides to cut the Shelter allowance aid, as they also called the Palestinian factions, the PLO, and the Human rights organizations to immediately move in order to put pressure on UNRWA to stop those decisions.

It is mentioned that the Palestinians of Syria and the Palestinian Local and Popular committees delivered a protest memo to the Head of UNRWA demanding to look back and to back down the UNRWA's decisions which will negatively impact the humanitarian and living situation of the displaced Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon.

The Committee also distributed the Eid clothes to the children included several areas in Turkey the last were Antakya, Al Athamna, Eskandaron and Al Raihaneyya.




Distributing food aid in Turkey

Numbers and Statistics till 15/7/2015

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 748 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 818 days, water was cut for 308 days

respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.

- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 629 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 610 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 812 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 455 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL SaiedaZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
