The Young man Deya Al Safouri from the Yarmouk camp died because of a wound that he attained due to a shell that targeted Al Reeja Square.

Recent Updates

Contradictory reports about the drowning of Palestinian Syrian refugees in the Mediterranean Sea after more than two boats were sunk. The first boat was launched from Alexandria in Egypt and was carrying about 400 refugees most of them are Palestinians from Gaza where the boat was damages after it was crashed with another boat.

Moreover, there is news about the sinking of another boat in front of the Italian coast that was launched from Libya and carries about 150 immigrants most of them are Africans. The destiny of the Palestinian refugees, who launched a mayday yesterday in front of the Italian coasts, is still vague. In the light of the contradictory reports, the Action Group couldn't make sure of the five names that are from the Gaza Strip which the Euro-Mid Observers for Human Rights published yesterday.

Bombing on the Yarmouk camp yesterday were several shells targeted separate areas in the camp which led to a youth victim, the victim is Deya Al Safouri from the Yarmouk camp because of a wound that he attained due to a missile on Al Reeja Square.

It was documented that a number of shells targeted Al Reeja Square, the surrounding roads, Al Forn Al Aali Street and the vicinity of Al Mansoura school which resulted in a number of injured people amongst civilians coincided with heavy clashes in Al Zahra neighborhood due to the entry of the Opposition militants to the camp and fighting the Regular Army checkpoints.

The UNRWA announced the close of all UNRWA schools in Al Zahra neighborhood in Damascus and its surrounding areas because of the clashes. On the other hand, the water crises continues in the camp where the whole houses of the camp suffer of the water cut since seven days which increases the crises that the residents live due to the siege which imposed on the camp for more than 424 days.

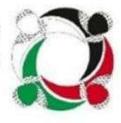


Injuries among children as a result of the bombing on Yarmouk refugee camp

In Damascus City, Khan Al Shaih camp for Palestinian refugees witnessed warplanes hovering that targeted the surrounding areas and sounds of heavy clashes were heard between the Regular Army and the Opposition Groups in Zakia area. It is mentioned that the Zakia road in Khan Al Shaih is the only remaining road that connects the camp with the other areas.

On the other hand, Al Nairab camp in Aleppo started the school year and the residents are loaded with economic crises which forced the youth to leave their work because of the security tensions in the camp and its vicinity. The Regular army and Palestinian factions loyal to the army control the camp which exposed it to frequent bombing and clashes from
