Recent Updates

According to reports from southern Syria, the Regular Army targeted each of Dera Camp, and Alsad Road Camp with mortar shells in addition to their surroundings leading only to material damages, and causing a state of terror among the children.

It is noteworthy that many of the Palestinian families, who fled from Dar'aa camp, are living in Albald area and Alsad Road Camp. The refugees of southern Syria are suffering of harsh living-conditions, while the other refugees in Der'aa Camp are suffering from very serious humanitarian situations, lack of health care, shortage of water since (859) days, shillings and frequent clashes inside the camp, which about 70% of the buildings in the Camp were destroyed.



On the other hand, after 1200 days of displacement, Handarat Camp residents re-call both sides of the conflict to get them back to their houses, and to put the camp aside, also they cleared that both of them are responsible of firing, and displacing us.

The plight is still ongoing as they were displaced and expelled from the camp since months due to the ongoing conflict in Syria, where some of the refugees were distributed on University accommodation in Aleppo, some of them went to Al Nairab Camp, and the others went to Turkey.

The new situation, poverty, humiliation, and disgrace that the refugees faced outside the camp, led to further tragedy, which forces some the refugee to get back to their houses, where they stayed for a period of time before being forced to move to Turkey through the northern borders of Syria. In Mars, more than 175 of the Palestinian-Syrian refugees-from Kilis village- moved to Turkey escaping the shillings, and cracker barrels that targeting the camp

On a different context, the Syrian regime continues to arrest the Palestinian, "Mohammed Mustafa Hamdan" (33 years) since 31/8/2013 until this moment, and that during passing Maliha checkpoint - a Syrian regime checkpoint- in the eastern Ghouta. It is noted that Mohamed is from the Yarmok camp, and no information received about him yet.



It is noteworthy that AGPS receives and documents many letters and information about the Palestinian detainees despite the documentation difficulties and despite hiding the detainees' fate, names, and place of detention. The AGPS documented until now, 1094 Palestinian prisoners in the Syrian prisons, while 450 were tortured to death.

Yesterday, 15 / August, the first Teaching- English Language camp was launched in Lebanon with the participation of more than 60 students of the Palestinian- Syrian refugees living in Lebanon. The camp is entitled "learn for the sake of Palestine", also a delegation from the Palestinian volunteer teachers born in Europe in addition to a number of Palestinian teachers residing in Lebanon is participating in the camp.

The camp, which was held and coordinated with joint efforts of Palestinian institutions, and joint coordination between the Palestinian teachers union in Europe, Palestinian-Syrian teachers union in Syria and the Association of Palestinian teachers in Lebanon, will continue for ten days and the first five days will take place in the Deba area in Beirut and then in Sofer Bhamdoun. The camp included entertaining educational workshops r provided by volunteers with expertise in this subject as well as playing sports.

In turn, one of the participants considered this camp as new experience with new educational system that aims to make teaching English Language easier for the Palestinian-Syrian students.

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon

- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid 2016
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1156 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1216 days, water was cut for 705 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1008 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 199 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 859 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
