### *“Snipping and Explosive Bomb in the Yarmouk Camp”*

### **Recent Updates**

*Snipers targeted the main street in the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus, which resulted in a case of fear and tension amongst its residents who were gathered since early morning at Al Rija Square waiting to receive food baskets provided by UNRWA. According to a civilian testimony, the snipers of the regime targeted the main street of the camp, and this was not the first time, while each time of aids distribution, the snipers open their dastardly fire on the residents in order to stop the food aids distribution.*

*He added that the two parties of the conflict are responsible of protecting the civilians during the aids distribution, it is mentioned that UNRWA limited the distribution of food aid to the people of the Yarmouk camp to three days a week, which are: "Thursday, Friday and Saturday". On the other hand, an explosive bomb exploded yesterday evening in Palestine*

*Meanwhile, strong explosion sounds were heard in Jermana Camp as a result of the intensification of clashes between the Syrian opposition forces and the Syrian regime forces in areas adjacent to the camp, causing a state of panic among the residents who complain of overcrowding, lack of basic services and scarcity of food, medicines and fuel. It is referred that Jeramana camp receives thousands of displaced families from the Palestinian refugee camps and areas adjacent to it because of the deteriorating security conditions.*

*The open sit-in continues in Greece, which was carried out by a number of Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees, who were rescued by the Greek Cypriot Coast Guard on 26/9/2014, while the refugees were placed in a (refugee Camps) in the Cypriot capital Nicosia.*

*The Group correspondent reported that three Palestinian families and a number of youth, who were residing in Kilis center in the Syrian Turkish borders, returned back to Syria because of the deteriorating of the miserable living situation and the high prices in addition to the lack of sources of living.*





*The correspondent added that the Palestinian refugees in Kilis center are complaining of the negligence of the UNRWA and the international organizations, as they were not receiving any food aids three months ago, according to their testimonies.*

*In a related context, the Turkish authorities previously issued a decision to vacate the Kilis shelter from single Palestinian Syrian refugee youth, and the application of this decision by the General Authority for Palestine Refugees in the temporary Syrian government as the body who responsible for the center to informs the young singles inside the center of this decision, which gave them a deadline to leave to avoid any action that may be taken by the Turkish authorities against them.*

*The Turkish authorities justified that its decision came to put an end to the problems caused by the presence of young unmarried couples with families in one place. It is noteworthy that dozens of residents of Palestinian refugee camps fled to Turkey since the beginning of the events in the city of Latakia and Al Raml camp a month ago 8/2011 AD, according to UNRWA recent statistics, the number of Palestinian refugees from Syria to Turkey amounted to 1,500 people.*

### ***Arrest***

*The Syrian Security Forces arrested “Maysoun Hadied” in AL Aedein Camp; she is an employee at Bisan Hospital and was arrested on 11-10-2014 at the Department of Immigration and Passports.*



### **Civil Work Committees**

*The administration of the Palestinian Red Crescent in the Yarmouk Camp, organized a meeting with its volunteers to discuss the latest developments related to the work of the Red Crescent in the Yarmouk Camp.*

*The meeting also addressed to the subject of the development of the skills and capabilities of the medical staff and the volunteer in order to serve the people of the camp and provide a helping hand to them. It should be noted that during the meeting the administration announced about preparing for the start of two sessions, one of them entitled "Introduction to Pharmacology and pharmaceutical shapes " the second session entitled "Carry, transport and evacuation of the injured during accidents and disasters".*

*On the other hand, Jafra Foundation opened a kindergarten "martyr Mahmoud Kassem Asaad" in Khan AL Sheih Camp in Damascus city in order to care for children and provide free educational services for them. In Lebanon, each of the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon and Palestinians of Syria workers Gathering, and with the support and funding of AL Wafaa European campaign, the Danish Charity Crescent, and Al Rahma Austrian Foundation, have supervised on the restoration and maintenance of Noor charity shelter, which houses 14 family of Palestinian refugees from Syria.*

*As in Turkey, the General Authority for Refugees (UNHCR) in Syria of the Syrian temporary government and in collaboration with the Organization of I.M.C, established handy courses for Palestinian Syrian refugee women in Kilis shelter on the Syrian-Turkish border, under the slogan " the Palestinian Women, a mother and a Worker" in order to support women by securing Minimum self-sufficiency for the Palestinian family and training on making woolen clothes for her children. It is noteworthy that the number of Palestinian Syrian families in Kilis center reached (94) family of nearly 520 people.*

***The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:***

- *The Yarmouk Camp: - The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 470 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 551 days and the water cut for 38 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 370 days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 340 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 539 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - Almost 185 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp:-bombing targeted the vicinity of the Camp and the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed.*
- *Khan Danoun Camp: - economic crises and difficulties of finding houses due to the overcrowding of the camp.*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - the power is still cut for more than a year.*
- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.*
