#### **Statistics**

The AGPS monitoring and documentation team confirmed that it documented yesterday the data of 63 Palestinian children who were killed due to bombing and siege on the Yarmouk Camp in Damascus.

The team expected that the real number is greater than that, because of the inability to document the ages of all victims because of the tense situation that accompany bombing and clashes often.

The AGPS statistics indicates that the number of victims in the Yarmouk refugee camp has reached 1200 victims, including 177 victims died due to lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege on the Yarmouk refugee camp, and 46 victims died since the storming of ISIS last April.

#### **Victims**

The Palestinian refugee Mohammed Mahmoud Shaker, Abu Qasem, Died the day before yesterday due to wounded he attained following the heavy shelling with explosive barrels that targeted the Yarmouk camp, which resulted in a number of victims and injuries.



## **Recent Updates**

An explosive bomb exploded at dawn yesterday, in front of a house in Muzareeb town resulted in a state of panic among residents, according to

activists, unidentified group planted an explosive bomb in a car belonging to one of the town's civilians, while there were no reports of casualties among residents.


A similar bomb exploded days ago, while many residents put responsibility of this explosion on the Syrian regime and affiliated groups. According to a residents, "many pro-regime groups plant explosive devices in the opposition controlled areas that targeted armed opposition fighters or to fabricate crises and problems that will ease the pressure on the regime fighting axes."

In the south of Syria, massive destruction of buildings and property at Daraa Camp following the bombing with explosive barrels and cluster bombs that targeted the camp the day before yesterday.

Meanwhile, the Syrian warplanes dropped two explosive barrels and cluster bombs on the camp, resulted in a number of wounded among residents and massive destruction to houses.

#### The destruction in Daraa Camp

Turning to Homs, where Syrian security services in the city of Homs arrested the Palestinian young man "Musab Ahmed Khalifa" on 12.07.2015, at the "university city" crossing on the south side of Al Aedein camp; he is in his thirties, a father of two children, and he is originally from the city of Safed in Palestine.

The Palestinian young man, "Hussein Ali Bayan" was also arrested on 06.05.2015, at Al Shabakat crossing "Bilal Mosque" in the south eastern side of Al Aedein camp; he is in his thirties, originally from the city of Safed in Palestine.

It is noteworthy that the Syrian security services set up iron and dust fences on the vicinity of the camp, and made specific ports for residents to pass through it, under the pretext of protecting the area from armed opposition groups.

In a related context, Syrian security forces released the Palestinian refugee "Mohammad Zahir" after being arrested for more than two and a half years; he is from Al Aedein camp in Homs, and he was arrested at

the so-called the 68 checkpoint. During his detention, news spread about his death in Syrian prisons.

It is noteworthy that 95 Palestinian prisoners from Al Aedein camp are still in the Syrian prisons, according to the AGPS, their fate and place of detention are still unknown.

#### Civil Work Committees

Charity Organization for Relief of Palestinian People honored 70 outstanding male and female university students from Al Aedein camp in Homs.

It is worth mentioning that Al Aedein camp in Homs is witnessing a state of calm under security tightening by the regular army checkpoints, amid frequent arrest campaigns against the residents of the camp.

Meanwhile, Al Wafaa convoy (13) distributed some financial aid to Palestinian Syrian displaced families in the north of Lebanon camps and areas.

#### **Turkey**


Turkish news agency "Anatolia" reported that the Turkish Coast Guard was able to rescue 240 illegal immigrants off the coast of the states of Aidan and Jnaq Castle, during their attempt to travel to Greece illegally.

According to the agency report, the Coast Guard teams of the State of Oevajak area Jnaq Castle rescued 159 people from the nationalities of Syria, Afghan, and Pakistan claimed that the Greek Coast Guard sank the boats which they were on board.



The illegal immigrants in Turkey

Immigrants were transported to the port of Behrmcale and handed over to Turkish gendarmerie teams that will carry them in turn to the government hospital Oevajak to make the necessary medical tests and then to the foreign branch of the Security Directorate.

In the same context, the Turkish authorities at the state of Aydin coasts announced that the coast guard arrested 81 illegal immigrants in the Didim area were trying to travel to the Greek islands, and were on board two boats, including women and children, all of whom are coming from Syria, was transferred to the jurisdiction of the Security Directorate.

#### Numbers and Statistics till 16/7/2015

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 749 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 819 days, water was cut for 309 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 177 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 630 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 611 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 813 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.

- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 456 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
