"The Palestinians of Syria Complain of UNRWA Partial Deductions of their Monthly Allowance"

Recent Updates

A number of Palestinian Syrian Refugees in Lebanon complain of the UNRWA unjustified partial deductions of their monthly allowance, where UNRWA deducts 100 thousand Lebanese Pound, about 6\$, monthly from the account of the Palestinian Syrian families in ATM cards without explanations. The refugees demanded UNRWA in Lebanon to explain and clarify the real reasons of the unjustified deductions which affected a large segment of the beneficiaries; they also considered the deduction as an illegal operation.



In Southern Damascus, violent overnight bombing targeted separate parts of the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees, where Palestine street was targeted with heavy shells that caused huge damage to the civilians' houses late at night. AGPS received news that a building was completely collapsed in Al Reeja square, where AGPS couldn't confirm the news due to the security tension in the camp.



It has been a year since the Syrian Army and Security forces committed a massacre against civilians from Khan Al Sheih Camp's residents. On 17 May 2016, the Syrian regime committed a horrible massacre which claimed the lives of 5 Palestinian refugees from Khan Al Shieh Camp in Damascus. The Syrian regime targeted a civilian car carrying several refugees while crossing through the only passage to the Damascus center, which claimed the lives of five refugees including a child and his mother. The Victims are: the child Mohammed Majed Sanad and his mother Rawda Jaber, Hamza Mohammed Al Daly, Hazim Husain Hazza', Owaid Mazhour in addition to a number of casualties.



The residents of Khan Al Shieh camp still suffer of the undeclared siege, which is imposed by the Regime's forces that prevents the entrance and exit of refugees without a permission. According to the AGPS correspondent, there are a lot of families who are outside of the camp and waiting the permission to return to their houses.

The AGPS correspondent southern Syria confirmed that the Palestinian refugees in Southern Syria live in difficult humanitarian situations; he added that cities and towns of Der'aa governorate, specially Der'aa



camp for Palestinian refugees, suffer from power, land communications lines, and water cut.

The liberated areas suffer of high prices of most food materials and high house rents, as well as the shortage of food, fuel, and a severe lack of baby milk, where it is not available in hospitals and pharmacies.

The public hospitals in Der'aa governorate suffer from severe lack of medicines and new medical devices in addition to the closure of many hospitals due to bombing and damage.

Relief Projects, Al-Khayriiah Association for the Relief of the Palestinian People, in cooperation with Al-Irshad and Al-Islah Association, distributed 200 food parcels to the displaced Palestinian Syrian families in Wadi Al Zaina south of Lebanon. According to the relief workers, the distribution comes within relief projects for the displaced and needed Palestinian Syrian families who live in Al Zaina valley area in Lebanon.





Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 17\05\2017

- *The AGPS documented 3498 Palestinian victims, including 461 women.*
- *1603 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 99 women.*
- *The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1398 consecutive days.*
- *195 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.*
- *It is now more than 1129 days without water in Deraa camp, and 980 days in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 1473 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 207 days.*
- *Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.*
