Recent Updates

For the third day respectively, the Syrian Regime continues bombing Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus Suburb with explosive barrels m mortar shells and heavy artillery.

The AGPS correspondent inside the camp referred that the Syrian warplanes throw yesterday four explosive barrels that targeted the vicinity of Villas street which led



to the death of fetus after his mom was injured with ruminants of Shells and also led to a number of injured people amongst the residents.

The Checkpoint of the Syrian Army at Artouz area prevents the transportation cars of Khan Al Sheih to leave the area. Some eye witnesses said that they changed the way to Keswa road in a time that all roads are still closed except Zakia Khan Al Sheih road.

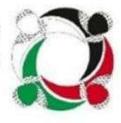


Continues bombing on Khan Al Sheih camp

Hamas called through its political office member Mr. Ezzat Al Resheq to immediately stop the bombing, targeting its residents and to take its siege away.

Mr. Al Resheq stressed on that targeting the camp is refused and condemned and exposing its residents to continuous siege which deepen their humanitarian tragedy and also demanded to neutralize the Palestinian camps from the ongoing conflict in Syria.

The AGPS correspondent at Al Nairab Camp reported that the Syrian Security and its affiliated factions seized a car which contained passengers heading to Turkey and delivered the car to the Syrian Security at AL Matar.

The Syrian Regime and its affiliated groups seized a car that was carrying passengers to Turkey and delivered the car to the Syrian Security before they were released the second day. It is referred that the Syrian Security prevents the leave of any Palestinian from the camp. The camp also witnessed a number of cases of youth that were returned from

the last checkpoint that separate the Syrian Security areas and the Opposition areas.

Violent clashes broke out on the sides of AL Nairab camp at Karm Al Tarrab and the airport vicinity as the Opposition is trying to go forward towards the military airport where the residents live in fear and worry state due to the deterioration of the security, living and economic situation.

On the other hand, no new developments during the last period of Al Sbeina camp for Palestinian refugees at Damascus Suburb and the Syrian Army and some affiliated groups still prevent the residents to return back to their houses and properties.

The suffering began after they were obliged to leave due to violent clashes between the Syrian Army and the Opposition groups that ended with the full control of the Regular Army over the camp on 17th of November 2013. The residents who fled to the surrounding areas and camps which engaged them in new suffering that didn't stop to leave their houses but it was extended to reach all aspects of their lives and tragedy due to the economic conditions and the spread of unemployment and the lack of financial resources.

Detainees

One of the checkpoints of air security, which is located after the city of Hama, north and before "Mork" area, arrested three Palestinian refugees from Al Aedein camp in Hama; they are: "Nabil Abdul Salam

Salaymeh," "Shady Haitham Kassem," and "Talal Mohammed Abdullah "from Al Shajara village in Palestine.

It is noteworthy that the AGPS documented the names of 38 detainees from Al Aedein camp in Hama in the Syrian prisons, while their fate is still unaccounted for.

In the same context, and after losing him for several years, a released detainee, who refused to reveal his name, claimed that he saw the 16-year- Palestinian Syrian boy "Omar Mohammed Siam," from Yarmouk. The boy has been lost since 21/11 / 2012 and it turned out that he was detained in a Syrian security branches in Damascus, note that the latest information reached about him was a year and a half ago.

Commissioner-General of UNRWA "Pierre Krenpol" assured that funding for UNRWA's emergency appeal rate for Palestinians of Syria for 2015 amounted to a rate of only 27 %".

He added that "the agency finds itself in an awkward situation, as it faces the most serious financial crisis ever, and a shortage of financing its key

activities, such as providing schools for half a million children, to cover the 2015 with value of \$ 101 million."

Pierre Krenpol pointed out that the agency was forced to reduce the frequency and the amount of cash aid that is distributed to the refugees in Syria in cases of extreme exposure to risk."

He also noted that the Palestine refugees from Syria in Lebanon do not get shelter allowance which will reflect negatively on those families that do not have any mean to secure housing.

Commissioner-General of UNRWA "Pierre Krenpol" stated that isolation, exclusion, and denial of Palestine refugees of Syria, Gaza, the West Bank, Jordan, and Lebanon represent a time bomb for the Middle East".

It should be noted that UNRWA has recently taken a series of decisions in order to reduce its services, and to stop operating in five areas, which provoked a state of anger and resentment among the Palestinian refugees

who constantly threatened to escalate the popular protest movements against the cuts policy followed by UNRWA.

Numbers and Statistics till 17/6/2015

- 80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.
- At least 35,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 891 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 720 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 790 days, water was cut for 280 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 601 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 582 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 784 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 427 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
