"Abbas" Extremist Organizations are hindering the Process of Citizens' Return to the Yarmouk Camp"

"Jamal Abu Hashish" 50 years, Palestinian, from the Yarmouk camp was killed due to torture in the prisons of the Syrian regime, bringing the number of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture since the beginning of this month, August, to thirteen.

Recent Updates

Palestinian President "Mahmoud Abbas" said "that there are extremist organizations hinder the process of citizens' return to Yarmouk camp, stressing that efforts are still ongoing for the return of all the people of the Yarmouk refugee camp in Syria, considering that "what is happening in Syria is an internal affair, nothing to do with it."

Mr. Abbas said, in previous statements in front of the Revolutionary Council of Fatah, that "The Popular Front - General Command is responsible for the crisis in Yarmouk". The General Command condemned those statements and accusing Mr. Abbas that he is Indulged working against the Syrian regime.

It is noteworthy that the Yarmouk camp in Damascus is subjected to a strict siege for more than a year and the camp is suffering from health and living crises resulted in the death of 154 refugees died because of hunger and lack of medical care.

Meanwhile, clashes broke out, yesterday, between armed brigades inside Yarmouk and the regular army alongside with the Popular Front - General Command on the municipality Yarmouk crossing at the Palestine Street. The clashes coincided with the targeting of Alrigha Square with two RBG shells and snipers targeted the Yarmouk Street and the main boulevards leading to the Street of the Girls High School of Yarmouk near Al Tadamon area.

A state of panic and fear prevailed in among the residents of Jaramana camp in Damascus city, after hearing the voices of powerful explosions rocked throughout the camp and was later identified as a result of the fall of a number of mortar shells on the town of Jaramana targeted Al Basel and Al Khader Streets.





In terms of living situation, the suffering of the people is concentrated on the economic side, where they are suffering from high prices of food items in addition to the spread of unemployment, and it is referred that the camp receives many Palestinian families who were displaced from their camps because of the bombing and siege.

Egypt

The Egyptian Coast Guard arrested a group of Palestinians of Syria and Syrian refugees while trying to reach Italy from the Egyptian beaches, and imprisoned them at Rashidiyeh police station.

It is noteworthy that the Egyptian security forces, in 2nd August 2014, arrested a number of Palestinian and Syrian families while trying to reach Europe by sea, where a number of security members raided a compound to those families in one of the places near the sea of Alexandria and arrested them on charges of attempted illegally immigration. The refugees are detained in inhumane conditions in tight places with large numbers of detainees.

Libya

The Tribal Council for the Libyan city of Zuwarah in a statement, that Action Group had a copy of it, called to fight the illegal immigration that is launched from the city shores, where it called the people that are described as the family members of the city and who were getting money to smuggle people to stop those actions immediately.

The statement also called the parents of those who practice smuggling to repudiate the actions of their family members, while the statement stressed on the need to activate the security agencies to combat such acts.

It is noteworthy that Zuwarah city is from the most prominent Libyan cities where the illegal immigrations are launched from, including Palestinian refugees of Syria in order to reach Europe to escape the war in Syria.

Civil Work Committees

The volunteer group of the Department of Services in Palestine Charity Committee continues to work for several days to clean up sanitation networks at the end of the Yarmouk Street and in the road leading from Loubieh street to Zaid ibn al-Khattab mosque near Thalathein Street, in order to be ready to drain the water in the winter.
