AGPS

In the margin of its work to convey the suffering of the Palestinians of Syria to the various media outlets and the Human Rights centers, AGPS launched its documentation account on OXIMITY International Network, where the AGPS publishes its Human Rights and Documentations Reports through that account, coincided with publishing the news and reports through the AGPS Website, Social Media Networks and the E-Mailing List in English and Arabic languages.



It is mentioned that OXIMITY Network is a Forum for International News that gathered rich content news directly from the news contents makers and distributes it through internet all over the world by various channels which include writers, freelance journalists, artists, organizations, and independent media networks. It is mentioned that AGPS issued till today more than 1200 daily reports in English and Arabic languages in addition to more than 80 special reports about detailed problems and situation of the Palestinians of Syria, Moreover, more than 10 reports which include statistics about the Palestinian victims who were documented by the AGPS documentation and monitoring team. Victims

The Palestinian Refugee Samer Waleed Ghannam died yesterday due to a wound he attained in the bombing that targeted Yarmouk camp for Palestinian Refugees southern of Damascus, where the besieged camp witnessed a security tension situation due to the clashes which broke out since more than two weeks between Al Nusra Front and ISIS, each party is trying to control and extend the power over the camp.

Recent Updates

News were reported from Yarmouk camp stating that ISIS executed one of its members after he splintered off ISIS, where they killed him by shooting the child while he was in his house, it is noted that he is the brother of the child Yahya Al Asmar who was killed the day before by ISIS through sniping and shooting.

In the field, violent clashes broke out yesterday in western of Yarmouk street in Al Khamastaesh street where ISIS was able to control the security square which Al Nusra previously kicked out Al Ansar Group that is loyal to ISIS.



In the same context, some information leaked out about a letter that was sent to Al Nusra by ISIS through the civil delegation who mediated to set a daily truce between them, where stuck families in the clashing areas can be provided with food and water. The letter included an offer from ISIS to Al Nusra stating that Al Nusra withdraw from the vicinity of Masbah Al Basel east of the camp and from the last part of Al Jaouna street and the end of Haifa street towards Yarmouk Court vicinity north west of the camp.

The events came in a middle of a big worry and tension amongst the besieged and displaced residents of the camp because of the continuous control of ISIS and Al Nusra over their camp and the continuous clashes, bombing, and sniping which targeted the civilians and their houses, where the Regular Army and PFGC still impose a strict siege over the

camp since 1038 days respectively and the power cut since 1099 days and water cut since 588 days respectively.

In the northern of Syria , the Opposition military groups in Aleppo

declared the detention of the Palestinian refugee Khalid Musa "Abu Khareef" from the residents of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo after his participation in the fighting with Al Quds brigade which is loyal to the Army in the clashes going on Handarat camp against the Opposition military groups. It is noted that Al Quds brigade declared the death



of Khalid in the clashes in Handarat camp. It is mentioned that Al Quds Brigade recruits dozens of the Palestinian refugees in Syria to fight against the Opposition military groups under the pretext of protecting the camps, where dozens of the Al Quds brigade members died during their fighting beside the Syrian Regime who were from the residents from the Palestinian camps such as Al Nairab and Handarat in Aleppo and Al Raml camp in Lathekia.

In a different context, the Palestinian Syrian Refugee Abdel Wahab Hussine Yahiya launched a call through the AGPS to all human rights organizations, ICRC, and Civil organizations to immediately interfere to find his missing family in Germany since more than 20 days respectively.

Abdel Wahab Yahiya Said to the AGPS correspondent that he lost the contact with his wife and two female children Julia and Tulai after they

reached Germany. He noted that he was talking g to them through telephone but since 20 days he lost the contacts with them and no news about his family. He added that he is calling all concern parties and anyone who has their contacts to contact him because since he lost them he lives in depression and misery.

It is mentioned that AGPS documented many disappearance and family and children missing amongst the Palestinians of Syria who escaped the ongoing hell in Syria and were forced to leave and risk themselves and families riding the death boats and walking on foot for long distance searching for safety and security in the European countries.



Civil Work Committees

Within the Campaign "Daffeni 3" the Islamic Association for Orphans and Needy People Relief of the 48 Palestinians provided financial aid to the displaced Palestinian of Syria families in southern of turkey to alleviate their economic and living suffering.

It is worthy to mention that the Islamic Association sponsored about 500 displaced families monthly for 6 months. According to the Islamic Association, it is about to launch a project of sponsorship for all families where the Palestinians of 48 will sponsor the families of the Palestinians of Syria refugees who are displaced in Turkey according to the villages and cities that the families belong to.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 18\04\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1038consecutive days. Power cut

continued for more than 1098 days, water was cut for 588 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 893 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1086 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 746 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
