Recent Updates

The public recruitment department of the Syrian regime issued a decision to amend the law of travel guarantee, which the Palestinian and the Syrian refugee gets to postpone the compulsory service for 9 months. It also decided to reduce the duration of travel guarantee to only four months instead of nine, so the young man who can do the travel guarantee twice and gets postponed for 18 months, will not be able to have it after this decision and he only gets four months which costs 50 thousand Syrian pounds.



Despite that the continuations of imposing the compulsory military service on the Palestinian refugees in Syria by the Syrian Regime and the affiliated groups, the youth see that the travel guarantee law is a chance for them to ease their conditions without joining the army. It is noted that the agreement upon the travel guarantee is pawned to giving bribe for the regime members because most of applications are refused though paying the amounts due in the banks.

The Public recruitment management in Damascus generalized thousands of names who are wanted for the compulsory recruitment including Palestinian refugees. The activists referred that military police members and military groups affiliated to the regime checkpoints were spread in Damascus and stopped some youth and took their identities and investigated them for several hours, and then they arrested everyone who doesn't have delay paper.

It is mentioned that the Palestinian Syrian youth are facing difficult options due to the compulsory recruitment and the continuous chase for what is called county service. They immigrate out of Syria or run from the regime inside Syria to the areas that the regime doesn't control. The rest of remaining youth would live under siege, bombing and sniping inside their camps but not serving in the compulsory military recruitment.

In a different topic, the family of the Palestinian refugee Feras Tamim denied the death due to torture and insured that their son died a normal

death in Al Zahera area in the Yarmouk camp. It is noted that AGPS published earlier the news of Feras' due to torture according to different sources but his family denied it. It is referred that the process of documenting the Palestinian Syrian detainees and victims in the Syrian prisons is complicated due to the



secrecy of the Syrian security forces and the fear of the families to talk about the detention of their sons.

In a different topic, a Palestinian Syrian refugee from Khan Al Sheih in Damascus Suburb was injured due to bombing the surrounding farms in light of exposing Khan Al Sheih camp to a semi daily bombing with shells and warplanes, where the AGPS couldn't know the name of the injured refugee. It is noted that the Regular Army Checkpoints continue to cut all roads that connect the camp with the city center of Damascus the capital, which increased the humanitarian suffering inside the camp specially the medical and living situations.

In a related context, ISIS released the Palestinian refugee Mr. Abu Rafat Ouda after three days of kidnap in the besieged Yamouk camp for different reasons. It is mentioned that ISIS imposes its control over wide parts of the camp, where the clashes continue between ISIS and Al Nusra front since 75 days respectively in most of the Yarmouk camp areas that led to the injury and death of a number of civilians and tightening their movements to get their basic daily needs.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 18\06\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015

- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1099 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1160 days, water was cut for 650 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 953 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 144 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 805 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
