Greece

A group of Palestinian and Syrian refugees are suffering of bad detention conditions in a Greek prison on the boarders with Albania, as they were arrested in Albania while they were trying to reach Serbia. The refugees were delivered to the Greek authorities which it turn arrested them inside a boarder prison, while the Action Group received news about a refugee who suffers of a severe health crisis ignored by the Greek authorities and not providing him emergency services.

Recent Updates

The clashes that broke out between the Syrian opposition forces and the Regime forces backed by troops of National Defense in Handarat Camp in Aleppo and the areas in Northern Aleppo city is still continuous. The clashes led to death and injuries from both sides, and a big number of houses are completely demolished due to the repeated heavy shelling of the camp that is controlled by groups of the Syrian opposition, who controlled the camp after violent clashes which forced the residents to leave the camp and fled to other camps and cities. In the Syrian capital Damascus, the distribution of limited quantities of food aids, provided by UNRWA to the besieged people of the Yarmouk refugee Camp, was resumed yesterday morning.

The residents gathered at Al Rija square waiting for their turn to receive food aids, it is mentioned that these aids have become the only source of food in the camp because of the siege that led to the out of all food and medical supplies.


It is worth mentioning that the residents of the camp are suffering of the continuing water cut for the 40th day respectively, as they also complain of the power cur for more than a year. In another context, an explosion sound were heard yesterday, turned out to be resulted in an explosive bomb placed in a car in Ata Al Zeir Street which led to a fire at Al Naji lane.

In Turkey, the Turkish police arrested 200 Palestinian Syrian and Syrian refugees while they were trying to migrate from Mersin area in Turkey, according to the Turkish newspaper, the Turkish policemen arrested 200 Palestinian Syrian and Syrian immigrants were about to ride a boat that was moored off the coast of Ardmly town. The refugees were transferred to a sports hall in the town, and then underwent medical examinations before being handed over to foreigners Division in the Security Directorate "Mersin.".

However, Turkish police arrested seven people from the ship's crew for aiding illegal immigration, it is referred that dozens of residents of Palestinian refugee camps fled to Turkey since the beginning of the events in the city of Latakia and Al Raml Camp since Augustus 2011. According to recent statistics by UNRWA, the number of Palestinian refugees coming from Syria to Turkey amounted to 1,500 refugees.

Civil Work Committees

The Palestine Charity Committee launched the project" Imatat Al Aza" in the Yarmouk Camp in order to lift the runes and garbage of the Camps' streets to avoid the spread of epidemics and diseases amongst the residents of the Camp.

The Committee started its project on Friday by lifting the garbage dump that located in Al ZAin neighborhood, while a voluntary team will clean the main streets and lanes of the camp from garbage. It is referred that this project comes in corporation with civil bodies and Committees who are working inside the Yarmouk Camp.

The Situation of the Palestinian Camps in Syria:

- The Yarmouk Camp: The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 471 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 553 days and the water cut for 40 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 372 days respectively.

- Al Sheina Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 341 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 541 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- Dara'a Camp: Almost 187 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp:- the roads that linking the camp to the city center are still closed except the Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: economic crises continue specially the unemployment and the high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: the power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
