“Turkish Authorities Release all Palestinian Syrian Refugees Detained in Adana Prison after issuing their ID Cards”



- The Action Group: 40 victims from Al Sayeda Zainab camp were killed since the beginning of the events in Syria.
- Heavy shelling targets the vicinity of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb.
- 157 victims were died due to starvation in the Yarmouk camp.
- A state of security tension prevail Al Wafedein camp vicinity in Damascus city.
- Activists demand the PLO and the Palestinian factions to intervene to return the residents of Husseneia camp to their homes.
- UNRWA still cuts its financial aids of hundreds of Palestinian Syrian families who were displaced to Lebanon.
- Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon participate in a solidarity meeting to support Jerusalem.

Turkey

Monitoring and documentation team in the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria revealed that the number of victims from Al Sayeda Zainab camp in Damascus suburb, since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached "40" victims, including 17 were killed by bombing, 12 were shot, 3 due to torture, 2 were field executed, a refugee was kidnapped and then killed, and another one was killed in a car bomb.

Recent Updates

A number of shells targeted the vicinity of Khana Al Sheih camp in Damascus suburb which was clearly heard inside the camp, coincided with the continuous closure of all roads that link the camp with the city center except for Zakia-Khan Al Sheih road.

The strict siege imposed by the regular army and the PFGC on the Yarmouk camp is still continuous for more than a year and a half, as they prevent the entry of food and medicine supplies, the movement of the residents, and fuel. It is mentioned that 157 victims were killed due to the lack of medical services and nutrition. The clashes and the bombing that targeted the camp are still continuous, while the Reconciliation delegation for negotiation on the Yarmouk neutralization and breaking the siege has left the camp but no information was leaked about the substance of the conclusion of the meeting.

On the educational side, the educational caseworker "Walid Kurdi" has entered the camp to check the educational reality in the camp schools.

While the people of Husseinia camp are still waiting for their return to their camp after the regime and the GC controlled it on 11.10.2013, after having been forced to leave their homes and belongings and fled to the Palestinian refugee camps adjacent areas.

In the same context, a number of activists criticize the position of the Palestinian factions and the PLO which presents initiatives to resolve the Yarmouk refugee camp crisis and forget the rest of the Palestinian refugee camps such as Daraa camp, Handarat, Husseinia and Khan Al Sheih camp.

Therefore activists called the PLO, UNRWA and the Palestinian factions to work seriously and intervene in order to neutralize all the Palestinian refugee camps in Syria and make it safe areas.

In the meantime, the residents of Al Wafedein camp are living a state of security tension because of shelling and clashes in neighboring areas between the Syrian opposition and the regular army groups. The residents of the camp, which includes a number of Palestinian refugees and displaced Syrians, also suffer of poverty, high unemployment and poor living conditions even before the events in Syria.

It is worth mentioning that Al Wafedein camp is located at the northern entrance of Damascus city on the highway between Damascus and Homs, away from the capital, Damascus, 20 kilometers bounded on the north, Highway Road and the south-east Adra Prison, on the south by the city of Doma, on the west of Al Iskan suburb, consisting organizationally of three neighborhoods, The first one is Al Joulan, the second one is October lane, and the third one is Al Thawra district, followed administratively to Quneitra, which was named officially (Batiha town for displaced people), and a population of about 53 thousand people, and the majority of its population are from the occupied Golan.



Lebanon

"UNRWA" fills ATM cards for Palestinian refugees from Syria who had written down their information with the agency until June 30, 2014, while UNRWA had stopped financial aid to hundreds of Palestinian families, starting from October 2014, explaining that the statistics that was carried out by the staff for collecting data on the social and economic situation of each family of Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria to Lebanon concluded that the number reached "44000" refugees after that number was, before the statistics, "51" thousand refugees.

On the other hand, Palestinians of Syria Commission in Lebanon participated in the solidarity meeting, which was called for by a number of NGOs in Lebanon. The meeting, which was held in the municipality Theater Hall of Sidon, addressed many of the ideas and suggestions that can be carried out by private institutions in order to support the steadfastness of the Palestinians in Jerusalem in the face of the Judaization policy in Jerusalem generally and Al-Aqsa Mosque in particular.

The Charity Commission for Relief of Palestinian People in Tuesday, on Tuesday 18th of November, launched its relief project (a touch Charity), which aims to distribute food baskets to the Palestinian families who had been displaced from the camps to areas and towns adjacent to them, where the commission distributed today 50 food baskets to families displaced in Jaramana area and Jermana camp.

The Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian people will distribute, tomorrow, food baskets at Khan Dannon camp in Damascus suburb.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics

- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 501 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 584 days, water was cut for 71 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.*
- *41 Palestinian refugees were killed outside of Syria.*
- *95 PLA members were killed due to Clashes in Syria.*
- *Al Husayneyya Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 403days respectively.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 372days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 572 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*
- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 218 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.*
- *Khan Danoun Camp: - Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.*
- *Al Nairab Camp: - Power is still cut for more than a year.*



- *Jermana, AL Saieda ZAINAB, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.*
