
Destruction in Yarmouk refugee camp

- A Palestinian refugee died by sniper shot.
- AGPS documented 39 names from Al Aedein camp in Homs were killed since the beginning of events in Syria.
- A number of mortar shells targeted the Yarmouk camp.
- The residents of Al Nairab camp in Aleppo are suffering of insecure and instability due to the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding places.
- Palestine Charity Committee distributes aids at Al Muzaireib compound.
- Palestinians of Syria in Burj Al Barajna camp sit-in in the occasion of the second anniversary of the Yarmouk Nakba.
- UNRWA: more than 14,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have fled to Jordan.

Victims

The old man "Mahmoud Mohammed Abdullah" was killed by sniper shot while he was at the Yarmouk Street, he is 73 years from the Yarmouk camp.

Statistics

Documentation team of the AGPS announced that the number of victims from Al Aedein camp in Homs, who died since the beginning of the events in Syria, has reached 39 victims, including 22 due to torture, 5 by shelling, 4 by a sniper shot, while 4 were killed by gunshot, one refugee was killed in a car bomb, two refugees were kidnapped and then killed, and a refugee was executed by white weapon.

Recent Updates

A number of mortar shells targeted different parts of the Yarmouk camp in Damascus coincided with the suspension of distributing food aid provided by the UNRWA for the second week respectively because of the outbreak of clashes between the affiliated groups on the Syrian armed opposition and the regular army alongside with the PFGC.

In the same context, armed groups inside the camp issued an oral statement about a cease-fire on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays from 5:00 am to 5:00 pm and to safeguard the civilian residents of the camp on

their way to receive the food baskets, in the meantime, the old man, "Mahmoud Mohammed Abdullah", 73 years, was killed after being shot by a sniper while he was on the main Yarmouk Street..

On the other hand, Al Nairab camp in Aleppo has witnessed an instability and safety state due to the deteriorating security situation in the surrounding areas, and involving some of his sons in the fighting alongside the Syrian army and that what exposed it to bombing led to a number of victims and wounded.

Violent clashes broke out yesterday between the Syrian opposition and the regular army forces in the vicinity of the camp, in addition to the bombing that targeted the areas adjacent to the camp, which led to the spread of panic among residents.

While conditions in Hittin compound in Barzeh in Damascus have not changed, where people are living under the control of units of the regular army and members of its security committees of Al Bayadir neighborhood and Ish Al Wirwar, due to its geographical location, which mediates contact and clashes between the free army groups and the regular army.

he area is located on the public road beside the services complex (which is driving the focus of the army and airforces in the north of Damascus), in addition to its proximity to the neighborhood Bayader pro-regime, also near Barzah the country, which was under the control of the free army groups, these things combined pushed the regular army to expel the

inhabitants of it and make it a region their own military, resulting in the destruction of a large part of the assembly houses as a result of the exchange of shelling between the two sides, as most of the houses which were stolen.

Release

The Palestinian refugee "Saleh Al Hakim" from Neirab camp in Aleppo was released after being detained for more than four months.

Civil Work Committees

The Palestine Charity Committee distributed (400) Share of heating materials to Palestinian families stationed at Muzaireib compound in Daraa, and states that the compound contains about (8500) refugees, receives hundreds of families who were displaced from Daraa camp because of the great destruction caused by the impact of repeated bombing of the camp in recent months.

Lebanon

Hundreds of displaced Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon organized a sit-in at Burj el-Barajneh camp in Beirut on the occasion of the second anniversary of the Yarmouk camp Nakba, where protestors called for

lifting the siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp and the return of families, while they also demanding the right resorting to EU countries and to ensure that they live in freedom and dignity.

Jordan

According to the statistical map of UNRWA, the number of Palestinian Syrians who are in Jordan has reached (14348) refugees until the end of November 2014, and states that the Jordanian authorities had previously taken a formal decision to ban the entry of Palestinian Syrian refugees into its territory, prompting thousands of them to hide their identity and claim that they are Syrians. Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan are suffering of harsh living conditions as they are distributed between asylum camps hiding their identity for fear of being deported, while there are a number of Palestinian refugees who fled the war in Syria themes under house arrest in the "Cyber City compound" as part of the bad living conditions where they are not allowed to move freely, and does not give them adequate assistance for a decent life.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics till 18/12/2014

- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 531 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 612 days, water was cut for 101 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached 157 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 433 days respectively.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 403 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 603 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 248 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia road.

- Khan Danoun Camp: Economic crisis is still continuing, specially unemployment and high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: Power is still cut for more than a year.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Ca mps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quite situation in light of the economic crises.
