RECENT UPDATES

"Jafra Foundation for Relief and Development" in cooperation with the relief and civil society foundations organized an a sit-in under the title "Al-Yarmouk's Black Day" in revival of the third anniversary of the catastrophe of Al-Yarmouk camp and the massacre of Abdel Kader Al-Husseini mosque carried out by the Syrian warplanes three years ago which led to dozens of the victims, injuries and the displacement of residents.



This comes while the regime's army siege and on Al- Yarmouk camp continued for the (900) day respectively, and the power cut for more than 970 days, running water for 460 days, and the number of siege victims reached (184) victim.

In Daraa, shelling and repeated clashes In Daraa camp south of Syria since the beginning of the war caused the destruction of 70% of its buildings, according to unofficial statistics, while the remaining residents inside the camp live in a serious humanitarian situation regarding health living needs.

As for health, there is no hospitals or medical centers in the camp, added to the severe shortage of medicines and materials of medical equipment, first aid, in addition to the need of ambulance cars to transport the injuries to get medical treatment outside the camp, even if they managed to get a patients outside the camp; the Jordanian Authorities don not let any Palestinian-Syrian even injured ones to enter. Regarding this deteriorating health situation, a number of activists inside the camp warned of the spread of diseases among people, especially with having to use contaminated drinking water, due to the running water cut since (606) days.



On other hand, The AGPS documented the names of 14 Palestinian detainees from Al-Muzeireeb, Daraa in the Syrian regime prisons, including a Palestinian women still unaccounted for until the moment of editing this news, Monitoring and documentation team believes that the real number could be even more, as the security situation and fears about the fate of their children prevent parents from the announcing the arrest incidents.

Al-Muzeireeb south of Daraa includes a gathering of Palestinian refugees estimated at 8,500 refugees, in addition to number of families who were displaced from Daraa camp. The AGPS has documented 1018 Palestinian prisoners in Syrian prisons since the start of the war.

CIVIL SOCIETY WORKS

Within the project "Together for Warm Winter" the Palestine Charity Organization in collaboration with the Life Road Association and the World Assembly of Muslim Youth, distributed olive dregs on Palestinian families displaced to southern Syria, in Almazirab and Gellin and Tel-Shihab areas to be used as a means of heating.

The olive dregs are all that's left of the olives after being squeezed including seeds and twigs and leaves, as it is a flammable material and helps to disseminate heating in case of use in Firewood heaters or in stoves Fire "fireplace" which is common because of the siege, and of the high prices and the lack of fuel.

On the other hand; Al-Wafaa European Campaign began yesterday, its first event in "Together For a Warm Winter" project, and started from Ain Al-Hilweh refugee camp in Lebanon. According to those in charge of the campaign, the delegation had a tour in the camp, to inspect the Palestinian-Syrian families' situation there, and distributed some of the materials and basic needs in the winter such as blankets and food parcels.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 18 December 2015

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 900 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 970 days, water cut for 460 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sheina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 761 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 962 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 606 days, and 70% of its buildings were distroyed.
