Malta

The Palestinians of Syria who were displaced from Syria to Malta made an appeal after the Maltese authorities beaten them to get the fingerprints of the refugees compulsory, which means to deprive them of join their relatives who went to other countries such as Sweden, Norway and Denmark ...etc.

It is referred that the Palestinians of Syria refugees who escaped from the ongoing conflict in Syria to Egypt to leave it through death boats to Italy but the Maltese authorities rescued them and forced them to land in Malta. Dozens of Palestinian and Syrian refugees made a protest in one of the refugee camps in Malta. The protesters condemn the inhumane treatment by the Maltese government and they demanded the ICRC, Human rights organizations, UNRWA, United Nations and the Palestinian factions to interfere to end their suffering inside the closed camps and to transfer them to the open camps and to stop all kinds violence and threats.

Recent Updates

The family of "Ghadeir Kayed Quseya", from Al Nairab Camp, was extremely shocked after they found their daughter still alive. In details, after a year of announcing her death due to wound she attained as a result of the bombing of Aleppo University, she was found in a hospital in Homs. Ghadeir was under treatment because of amnesia as a result of her shock.

According to the testimony of one of the nurses that Ghadir coincidentally saw a picture of her brother and recognized him and screamed, "this is my brother ... This my brother," and immediately they contacted her family to inform them that their daughter is alive, and added that the parents came and received the young woman and she is now in her house at Al Nairab camp.

Quantity of food parcels was distributed at Al Yarmouk camp north of Damascus. The parcels were given by UNRWA and the Charity Committee for Relief Palestinian people to the besieged people of Yarmouk camp for more than a year. A number of Palestinian families have returned back to the camp after the approval of Syrian Security after the security issued a list of 146 persons are allowed to enter the camp.

Meanwhile, the residents of Yarmouk camp are complaining of several crises, most important the water and electricity cut for more than a year in addition to the lack of medicine and medical supplies.

On the other side, Etein compound in Barza at Damascus is still under the control of the Regular Army Units and Security committees, loyal to it, from Al Bayader and Esh El Werwar Neighborhoods, because of its geographical location which is located in clashes area, clashes between the Free Army and the regular Army, on the public road besides the Services compound in addition to that it is close to Al Bayader

neighborhood which supports the Syrian Regime. It is also near the Barza Al Balad streets which were under the control of groups of the Free Army. All these reasons prompt the Syrian Army to displace its Etein residents and made it a military closed area which led to huge destruction in civilian houses due to the bombing from both sides and houses were stolen.

Arrest

Ahmed Al Sobi from Al Aedin camp in Homs was arrested while he was going to his work. It is referred that the number of the Palestinina detainees in the Syrian Prisons is 669 people since the beginning of the Syrian conflict till the end of July 2014 according to the documentation of the Action Group for Palestinians of Syria.

Release

The Algerian authorities released Khalid Abu Alail and Mohammed Mghames from Al Nairab camp on Saturday 30th of August 2014. They were released after their arrest in charge of falsifying passports that they got from Turkey to migrate to Europe

Civil Work Committee

The Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian People in Aleppo announced that it will begin to distribute food baskets on the Palestinian families that are registered in its records from Tuesday 2nd of September 2014 in its location in Al Shahbaa Al Jadeeda in Aleppo.

Croatia

The relatives of the Palestinians and the Syrian detainees made an appeal to the international and humanitarian organizations to interfere with the Croatian Government to release their sons who are detained in Zagreb of Croatia since 25 days. The detainees suffer of severe humanitarian conditions due to their detention and mistreatment. One of the detainees' relatives said that their detainees were obliged to pay 20 USD daily as a price for their place of detention. The Action Group demands the

Croatian authorities to release the Palestinians of Syria refugees and the Syrians and to treat them like other refugees in addition to put into consideration the legal and international conventions and to treat them like war refugees. It is referred that they ran away out of Syria because of the ongoing conflict in Syria to Greece then they were arrested while they were passing to Europe through the Croatian lands.

Egypt

The Egyptian security arrested a number of Palestinians of Syria families while they were trying to reach Europe through sea. The Egyptian security raided a gathering for these families in a place which is near the sea in Alexandria and they were arrested under the charge of illegal immigration. It is referred that it is not the first time that the Egyptian Authoroties arrest Palestinian and Syrian families and detaining them in bad conditions and for long periods.

Italy

The Action Group got news about that all the Palestinians of Syria refugees and Syrians, who were on the boat that were launched from Zowara of Libya on 28th of August 2014, are very well and reached Italy yesterday.

In the same context, on Sunday 30th of August, a Swedish ship rescued 200 refugees including Palestinians of Syria refugees and Syrians in the Mediterranean Sea near Crete Island wile they were in their way to Italy after the Swedish ship got a call from the Italian coastguards telling them that there is a boat in the sea about to drawn. It is refereed that the boat contained 200 refugees who need food, water and worm clothes.

Lebanon

On 30th of August 2014, a delegation from the Palestinians of Syria Committee in Lebanon paid a visit to Al Zaytouna Education and Social Society in Ein Al Helwa camp to cooperate and make networks with the organizations and the civil committees which are concerning with the Palestinians refugees were displaced from Syria to Lebanon. They agreed to cooperate between the Committee and the Society to help the
