Latest Developments

Palestinian refugee Ali AlMohamed, from AlMualaqa, in AlQuneitra's southern outskirts, was kidnapped and executed by ISIS-affiliated Khaled Ibn AlWalid Brigade.

Last month, three Palestinian refugees—Mohamed Kamal AlBeitari, from Tafas town; Faraj Mohamed Faraj, and Faris Ali AlGhazawi—were cold-bloodedly executed by ISIS mobs who broke into Jilin town.



Meanwhile, an offensive launched by the Syrian government forces on Deraa Camp in southern Syria using mortar shells claimed the life of the Palestinian refugee Mohamed Jamal AlMesri.

AlMesri's death brings the recorded death toll among the Palestinians of Deraa to 247.

In another development, tension has been running high in Yarmouk Camp for Palestinian refugees, south of Damascus, due to violent clashes between ISIS and Tahrir AlSham Commission.

Medium and heavy weapons were used in the hostilities, resulting in deaths and injuries on both sides. At the same time, the Syrian regime troops stuck various parts of the camp, resulting in material damage.



In a related development, the Syrian government forces have rebuffed appeals to allow the family of the injured Palestinian child Hamza Hassan access out of southern Damascus for urgent treatment.

The child was reportedly run over with a group of people in Beit Sahem town.

The child's family appealed to the reconciliation committee in southern Damascus to urge the Syrian government to secure a safe passage out of the camp via Babila-Sidi Mikdad checkpoint.

Sometime earlier, instructor Taysir Rahal, tutoring at Palestine Alternative School, run by the Jafra Foundation in southern Damascus, was shot and injured in his head by a sniper near AlShuhadaa Cemetery, in Yarmouk Camp, on his way to AlKadam neighborhood to meet with delegates of the local reconciliation committee over the child's need of urgent medical therapy.

Palestinians of Syria: March 19, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,469 Palestinians, including 455 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,176 Palestinian refugees, including 83 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,366 days in a row.
- 190 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,072 and 880 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,416 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 150 days.
- Government troops ban residents of AlSbiena Camp from returning to their homes for 1,221 days running.

- Over 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until mid 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
- 8,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are taking shelter in Turkey.
- 1,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in the blockaded Gaza Strip.
