Recent Updates

AGPS Documentation and Monitoring Team confirmed that it documented to date 3500 Palestinian Syrians, who died due to the ongoing war in Syria. The bombing led to the death of 1441 Palestinian refugees, 8722 died due to exchanged clashes between the Regular Army and the Opposition groups, 461 died due to torture in the Syrian detention and prisons. In the meantime, Al Kashif neighborhood and Al Sad Road neighborhood, which contains Palestinian refugee groups in Der'aa, was exposed to bombing with mortar shells that led to victims and mass destruction with houses. It is noted that most of Der'aa Camp's residents left to Der'aa neighborhoods, where 80% of its building were destroyed.

The residents of Al Sad Road neighborhood complain from the severe humanitarian situations due to siege, which is imposed by the Regular army on the camp and the surrounding areas, they also suffer from a

sharp shortage of food materials and the continuance of Power, water, communications cut for long periods.

In Southern Damascus, AGPS correspondent reported that violent clashes broke out between ISIS and Al Islam Army, an Opposition Armed Group, in south of Yarmouk Camp, he added that an Al Islam military group infiltrated the territory that ISIS controls at Al Zain neighborhood in Yarmouk and clashed with ISIS members, which resulted in deaths and casualties from ISIS and the arrest of one of ISIS members.



AGPS correspondent confirmed that Al Islam Military Group withdrew the body of an ISIS fighter to Yelda the surrounding town to Yarmouk camp. Local sources at Yarmouk camp said that ISIS established a school of 12-14 years and called the residents to send their children to this school, which is called the Military Sharia School for boys. For their part, the Yarmouk residents figured out that the announcement of establishing this school is to recruit their children and involve them in the fight for ISIS battles, which exhausts the camp and the surrounding areas, they also warned the residents to respond to the ISIS calls under

the pressure of siege and the absence of financial resources that is being used by ISIS.

In a different context, Syria surrounding countries still ban the entry of the Palestinian Syrian refugees to its lands though the bad security situation in Syria, which puts the life of the refugee fleeing from Syria to danger of death.

In Jordan, the Jordanian authorities ban the entry of the Palestinian Syrian refugees to its lands under any reason after the Jordan Government issued an official decision about that. In Lebanon, the Lebanese authorities put conditions that the refugees describe as insuperable conditions to allow them to enter its territories, activists confirmed that the Authorities in Lebanon only allow the Palestinians, who have documents to prove they have interviews with European embassies or bookings to travel through Beirut airport.

The Turkish stopped issuing visas for the Palestinian Syrians in Beirut branch to enter its lands for more than two years, where some of Turkish embassies in Golf states continue to issue visas for the Palestinian Syrian refugees who has residencies in those countries. According to human rights activists that those procedure endanger the life of the Palestinian Syrian refugees in Syria and Such acts constitute a violation of international law and norms ,which are related to refugees' protection during wars and crises.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 19\05\2017

- The AGPS documented 3500 Palestinian victims, including 461 women.
- 1603 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 99 women.
- The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1400 consecutive days.
- 196 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.
- It is now more than 1131 days without water in Deraa camp, and 982 days in the Yarmouk camp.
- Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 1475 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 209 days.
- Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.
