Victims

The Palestinian Syrian Child Muneer Mazen Hazeina, 9 years old, died in Al Maqasid hospital at Beirut after he attained a random bullet on 10th of June 2015. According to the activists, the bullet was shot during a funeral of a member of Hezballah brigade.



Recent Updates

Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian Refugees was exposed to violent bombing with explosive barrels, where the AGPS correspondent inside the camp insured that the warplanes fired a number of explosive barrels that targeted the main street in the camp, which just affected material damages. The AGPS correspondent referred that another explosive barrel hit near Al Huda mosque during the Friday prayer which forced the Imam to cancel his speech fearing on the civilians inside the mosque.



It is mentioned that Khan Al Sheih camp witnesses the most violent wave of bombing with explosive barrels, where the warplanes bombed the camp with more than 20

explosive barrels during the last four days, which led to the death of a women and her fetus after she attained a shrapnel of a shell and a big number of injured people due to bombing. The residents of Khan Al Sheih camp in Damascus Suburb appealed the PLO, the Palestine embassy in Damascus, the Palestinian factions, UNRWA and the human rights organizations to immediately interfere to stop the frequent bombing which targets their camp since days. Where the warplanes launch its raids on the camp using explosive barrels that caused huge damages in the camp and the residents stressed that there is no excuse to target the camp that it doesn't have any armed one who follows any side but thousands of civilians.

The last raid on the camp targeted the main street yesterday which led to mass damages to properties in addition to the horror state that spread amongst the residents who were praying the Friday prayer at the camp's mosque. One of the residents expressed, to the AGPS correspondent, the anger from the carelessness of the official Palestinian organizations and the international organizations to stop the massacre that the camp is exposed to. The activists also complain lack of interaction of the media and the human rights organizations with the suffering of the camp.

In Der'aa camp south of Syria, the warplanes bombed the camp with explosive barrels which led to a number of injured civilians and a huge damage in buildings and properties. The AGPS correspondent inside Der'aa camp mentioned that the camp was exposed to bombing with two explosive barrels on Thursday Friday night which just led to material damages.

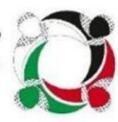
It is referred that Der'aa camp is exposed to frequent bombing that led to destroy about 70% of the buildings and houses of the camp where the remaining residents of the refugees inside the camp live in serious humanitarian situations manifested in the health and living aspects.

In Damascus, the checkpoints of the Regular Army allowed the day before the entry of the Palestinian students who got out of the Yarmouk camp since 20 days to do the High school exams, where all of students return back according to a previous agreement of the necessity to return all students after they finish their exams.



It is referred that 67 female and male students from the Yarmouk camp got out of the camp on 30th of May 2015 through Bait Sahm to do the High school exams for the school year 2014-2015, where the students headed to Saed Ib Elas for female students and Edadeiat Palestine for Male students in Al Ameen neighborhood "AL Alyans" in Damascus to accommodate there during the exams period. In a related context, Al Marhama campaign No 6 distributed some food aid on the residents of Yarmouk camp at Yelda town which surrounds the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees.

UNRWA

The UNRWA declared that it filled the accounts of the ATM card of the Palestinian refugees from Syria and who fit to have financial help according to UNRWA information till 15th of June 2015, the aid contains 40000 LP for each member of a family instead of food allowances and 150000 LP instead of shelter allowances.

The UNRWA declared that from the beginning of July UNRWA will reduce the financial aid of the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon through cutting the shelter allowances, it is noted that UNRWA previously reduced the financial aid from 45000 LP to 40000 LP and also stopped the monetary aid from 1200 Palestinians of Syria families in Lebanon since October 2014. It is mentioned that the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon, who are 45000 refugees, complain of the difficult living situation and economic crises due to the spread of unemployment due to the unavailability of the stable income that they can live with in addition to their unstable legal situation in Lebanon due to the laws that were set by the Lebanese authorities.


Civil Work Committees

The Palestinian of Syria committee in Lebanon in cooperation with Al Quds Charity committee distributed a number of food parcels in the occasion of Ramadan month on a number of Displaced Palestinian families from Syria at Al Beddawi camp in Tripoli north of Lebanon. The head of the committee in the camp insured that the food aid will include all Palestinians of Syria families who live at the camp and referred that they distributed at the first day about 130 food parcels on these families. It is worthy to mention that the number of the Palestinians of Syria families at Al Beddwai camp is 850 families from 45000 refugees who escaped to Lebanon from the ongoing war of Syria.

Numbers and Statistics till 19/6/2015:-

80,000 Palestinian refugees escaped from Syria, including 10,687 refugees in Jordan, 51300 refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till February 2015.

- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The number of Palestinian detainees who were documented by the AGPS has reached 896 detainees, and 398 victims were killed due to torture in the Syrian prisons.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 722 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 792 days, water was cut for 282 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 176 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 603 days respectively.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 584 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 786 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- **Dara'a Camp:** It is now almost 429 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
