Daily report on the situation of Palestinian refugees in Syria



"Three Palestinian refugees die because of the war in Syria"

- Syrian opposition open the Orouba crossing in front of the residents of Yarmouk camp for an hour
- ISIS publishes photos of executions it performed in south Damascus, against two people for "Apostasy"
- Palestinians in Syria Relief and Development Association holds a charity kitchen to provide relief to the people displaced from Yarmouk camp to the towns of south Damascus
- ATM cards for the Palestinian-Syrians in Lebanon packaged



### **Victims**

Palestinian refugee, "Mohammed Hassan" (Abu Hamza) has died after being hit by shrapnel of a mortar shell that fell while he was in the Zablatani area in Damascus. Palestinian refugee "Abdallah Amin Tamim," from the ranks of the Palestinian Liberation Army, also died while fighting alongside the Syrian regime forces in the ongoing clashes in Al-Rayhan Farms, in the eastern Ghouta.

Pages loyal to the Syrian regime reported news of the death of Palestinian refugee "Nedal Raouf Darwish," from the Jaramana refugee camp, where the pages mentioned that he died as a result of the Syrian war, without providing further details about the reason for his death or his location.



## **Latest Developments**

Our correspondent in Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus confirmed that the Syrian opposition allowed the opening of the Orouba crossing yesterday, which is the only port for the residents of the camp, for one hour only. About 20 families were allowed to pass through it, before it was closed again immediately.



Our correspondent noted that the opening of the crossing took place in the evening, making a number of families leave as they thought the checkpoint would not open. Our reporter added that the Syrian opposition factions did not provide a mechanism for operation of the crossing within the upcoming days, as well as not confirming whether or not it will reopen the checkpoint.



The armed Syrian opposition factions closed the Orouba crossing completely two days ago, where it closed the road with dirt mounds to ban any movement through it.

In another context, ISIS published photos on its website showing its members perform executions in Yarmouk camp, against two men accused of apostasy.

The Action Group refused to publish the pictures due to their ugliness, however they showed members of ISIS as they executed two men in Yarmouk camp, in an extremely brutal way, by firing gunshots directly at their heads.

ISIS has committed and continues to commit a number of violations against the civilians since its control over Yarmouk camp in early



April 2015. It has also implemented a number of punishments such as whipping, hand-cutting and foot amputations against civilians, on charges of committing legal violations, according to its claim.

In Lebanon, UNRWA packaged the ATM cards for the Palestinian-Syrian refugees displaced to Lebanon and a sum of \$100 was provided as a rent allowance for every Palestinian family from Syria, as well as 40 thousand Syrian pounds, equivalent to \$27, as food allowance for each person.

The number of Palestinian-Syrian refugees in Lebanon is estimated at 31 thousand, according to UNRWA's statistics until the end of December 2016.

### **Local Work Committees**

The Palestinians in Syria Relief and Development Association held a temporary charity kitchen, in an attempt to alleviate the suffering of the families that were displaced from Yarmouk camp, to the neighboring towns of Yelda, Babilla and Beit Sahm a few days ago, as a result of the deteriorating security conditions and the bombardments of Yarmouk camp with explosive barrels and mortar shells, as well as the ongoing clashes between ISIS and the regime, and ISIS and Hayat Tahrir Al-Sham.

On its part, the Association called on all the charitable associations and institutions and the expatriate residents of the camp, to stand by their own people, and to help and assist them.



Thousands of Palestinian refugees had fled from Yarmouk camp to the three neighboring towns to escape the bombardments of the Syrian regime and the control imposed by ISIS over the camp, and are living a life of misery and great suffering.



## Palestinians of Syria: March 20, 2018 Statistics:

- The total number of victims documented by the Action Group is 3680, including 467 women
- 1673 Palestinians are locked up behind Syrian government's bars, 106 of which are women
- Yarmouk refugee camp is under the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine's siege for 1,706 days in a row
- 206 refugees, mainly in Yarmouk Camp, have died due to lack of medical care and malnutrition
- Water supplies have been cut off Deraa Camp for 1442 days, and 182 days in Yarmouk Camp



- The Regime army has been in control of Handarat camp for more than 537 days. More than 80% of its buildings have been completely or partially destroyed.
- Approximately 85 thousand Palestinian-Syrian refugees fled to Europe by the end of 2016
- 31 thousand refugees are located in Lebanon
- 17 thousand refugees are sheltered in Jordan
- 6 thousand refugees are in Egypt
