Victims

The refugee, Ahmed Merwan Al Saad, a member of "Abnaa Al Yarmouk movement-AlBuraq Brigades, died on Thursday while fighting alongside ISIS in the Yarmouk camp south of the capital Damascus. He died during the ongoing clashes that broke out at the beginning of April 2016 between ISIS and Al Nusra.



Recent Updates

Palestinian and Syrian activists in France launched a campaign titled as "Detainees First," to shed the light at the case of the detainees in the prisons of the Syrian regime.

The campaign came within international activities, and as a humanitarian mobilization for the freedom of the Syrian detainees. The campaign is preparing for a march at the Place de la Bastille in Paris on Saturday 11-6-2016, according to a coordinator of the campaign.

The campaign's Facebook account published that "We are not talking about only prisoners, including Women and children who are deprived of freedom, but we talk about thousands of missed and kidnaped people who are unaccounted for, as well as thousands of detainees who are systematically starving or tortured to death. All of this comes under the heading of crimes against humanity according to Article VII of the Rome treaty in 1998.

The campaign put the international community responsible of the continued detention of detainees and abductees everywhere in Syria, for the Syrian regime, which turned into an Emirate of war as the country has its seat in the United Nations and contrary to the decision of the international Security Council in the text of article 12 of resolution 2254 of 2015, according to the campaign.

The campaign also called on the international community, the international human rights organizations, the civil society, and all those who have a sense of responsibility towards the humanitarian affiliation, to unite in the face of the perpetrators of crimes against humanity in Syria.

In addition, they called for in particular Russia and America, to give effect to the principle of the responsibility to protection which was approved by the United Nations in 2005, and to work on the formation of

an international working group to resolve the issue of detainees and abductees in Syria.

It is scheduled that the demonstration will raise the image of a thousand prisoners and detainees, who died under torture in a different standard format in order to draw the attention of European citizens, jurists, and politicians to the suffering of thousands of people in the Syrian cellars.

The AGPS documented 1076 Palestinian detainees in the prisons of the Syrian Regime, while the security forces are still reticent about their fate, in addition to 440 victims who died due to torture.

Heavy explosions rocked Khan Al Shieh camp in Damascus suburb after the warplanes targeted its vicinity with 42 explosive barrels, resulting in a state of panic among residents. Meanwhile, the regular Army is still closing all roads connecting the camp and the adjacent areas, which doubles the suffering of residents regarding health situation, and the provision of medication, basic materials, and baby milk.



Fighting and clashes are still ongoing in the besieged Yarmouk camp south of the capital Damascus for 43 consecutive days between ISIS and

Al Nusra, which led to the death of tens of members from both sides. ISIS members sneaked at Al Thalatheen Street west of the camp and resulted in violent clashes between them and the Nusra.

This coincided with sniping operations from the hall towers and Sufian Althawri barracks controlled by Assad's forces and Palestinian groups overlooking the camp. The sniping targeted overlooking buildings on Al Thalatheen Street, while activists accused the regular army members of complicity and overlooked ISIS members while trying to sneak. Meanwhile, violent clashes broke out between the Syrian regime alongside the affiliated groups and Al Nusra Front on several axes of the camp.



This comes in light of ISIS attempts to impose new restrictions over the residents at the Yarmouk camp who are besieged at the clashes areas with Nusra Front, as they were prevented to enter food and water to the besieged areas, according to a number of residents. The regular army and the affiliated groups are still besieging the camp for 1070 days respectively, as they cut power for more than 11311 days, and water for 620 days respectively.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 20\05\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1070 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1131 days, water was cut for 620 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sheina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 924 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1 115 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 777 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
