Latest Developments

A report released by AGPS on the eve of the World Refugee Day kept record of the death of 3,521 Palestinian refugees due to war-related incidents in Syria.

Shelling took away the lives 1,146 Palestinian refugees while deadly clashes between the Syrian government forces and the opposition outfits claimed the lives of 885 refugees. 462 Palestinians were, meanwhile, tortured to death in Syrian government penitentiaries. 196 others died as a result of the blockade imposed on Yarmouk. Hundreds of Palestinians have been pronounced dead outside Palestinian refugee camps and on the migration road.



Meanwhile, AGPS has called on the Syrian regime to disclose the fate of hundreds of Palestinian detainees who have gone missing so far.

AGPS documented the incarceration of 1,611 Palestinians in Syrian penal complexes since the outburst of the deadly warfare in 2011. AGPS estimates the real number to be far higher due to the gag orders slapped

by the Syrian government on the detainees' names and fates, along with the families' reluctance to report such cases for fear of retaliation.

AGPS kept record of several cases where Palestinians have been kidnapped at government checkpoints or during assaults carried out by the regime troops on Palestinian shelters. In most such cases, the detainees' families receive their relatives' bodies from a military or government hospital while wrapped up in a plastic bag or in a bloodtainted piece of cloth.

In another development, the Syrian government forces showered o Monday Daraa Camp and AlSadd Road, housing Palestinian families, with barrel bombs.



On Tuesday, the Syrian government warplanes struck AlMuzireeb town, in Daraa's western outskirts, home to 1,700 Palestinian families. Heavy material damage was inflicted by the onslaught.

Over recent weeks, bloody hostilities between the government troops and the opposition battalions have reached a zenith in AlMuzireeb.

In the meantime, UNRWA transferred cash aids for the Palestinians of Syria in Lebanon via ATM cards.

Every Palestinian family from Syria received a rental allowance of \$100 and a food allowance worth 27\$ per every refugee.

Palestinians of Syria: June 20, 2017 Statistics:

- At least 3,521 Palestinians, including 463 women, were killed in war-torn Syria.
- 1,612 Palestinian refugees, including 100 women, are incarcerated in Syrian government lock-ups.
- Yarmouk refugee camp has been blockaded by the Syrian regime army and Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command (PFLP-GC) for 1,427 days in a row.
- 196 Palestinians died of undernourishment and medical neglect in the blockaded Yarmouk Camp.
- Water supplies cut off in Deraa and Yarmouk camps respectively for 1,163 and 1,014 days.
- Residents of Handarat Camp, in Aleppo, denied access to their homes for 1,507 days. Government battalions have been holding sway over the camp for more than 241 days.
- Nearly 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees fled to Europe until the end of 2016.
- 31,000 Palestinians from Syria are housed in Lebanon.
- 17,000 Palestinians from Syria are taking refuge in Jordan.
- 6,000 Palestinian-Syrian refugees are sheltered in Egypt.
