Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent in Damascus suburb reported that Khan Al Sheih camp and its vicinity were exposed to targeting yesterday with explosive barrels and artillery shells, where the Syrian Army targeted Al Huda Mosque in the middle of the camp with tow mortar shells which spread a state of terror amongst the residents of the camp and material damages.



The camp was bombed with 4 explosive barrels and a number of mortar shells and hit the vicinity of the old market near Al Reda Street and the vicinity of Thanaweyat Khan Al Sheih. The AGPS corresponded said that the bombing targeted a house for Karim family near Al Reda mosque and Karim is from Khan Al Sheih residents as the surrounding farms were targeted from the side of Autostrad Al Salam.

It is referred that Khan Al Sheih residents, in western of Ghouta in Damascus, insured that the camp is empty from the weapons and armed people and insisted on the necessity to neutralize the camp from the ongoing conflict in Syria. The camp includes about 12000 civilians in addition to hundreds of displaced people from western of Ghuta cities

and towns such as Madameyat Al Sham, Dareya due to the deteriorated security situation.



On the other hand, AGPS documented three cases of detention from the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Al Aedin camp in Homs, where Mahmoud Mohammed Awad was arrested while he was returning from his work as glass worker in Husaya Industrial area on 10/8/2016. It is mentioned that Mahmoud is from the people who settled their situation since three years in the refugees' organization in the camp for the military headquarters and all factions; he is in his thirties and from Al Jash viliage in Palestine.

It was documented that Fayes Khalid Sammour was also arrested on 7/8/2016 and he is from the people who settled their situation since three years and from Safad city in Palestine. Ahmed Sammour was also arrested on 6/8/2016 and from the people who settled their situation since three years and from Safad city in Palestine. In the same context, the Syrian Security released the Palestinian refugee Mohammed Salayma "Abu Al majd" after 9 days detention, where Syrian Security raided his

house in Al Aedin camp in Homs on 11/8/2016 and was arrested due to illegal travel to Turkey then to Sweden.

It is mentioned that Al Aedin camp in Homs is under the control of the Syrian Regime and some loyal factions and also the camp is exposed to frequent detention raids once in a while.

In a different topic, the Greek Coast Guards rescued on Friday 19/8/2016 more than a hundred immigrants near Peloponnese and the coasts of Mykonos Island in Eja Sea, where a wooden boat carrying 67 immigrants including 13 children sank after it crashes in a rock in front of Matony sea port. The immigrants launched a distress call and a rescue team reached them and transferred all of them to Matony. According to the media outlets that the immigrants who were not specified their nationalities were thinking to leave from Greece to Italy and the accident happened in front of Mykonos coasts, where a boat carrying 36 immigrants including 7 children san near Fraghya coast.

In a related context, 6 immigrants including two female children died in a boat that capsized off on Thursday in front of the Libyan coasts, 21 immigrants were rescued and some survivors said that 27 people were on the boat including 8 Syrian families.

It is referred that thousands of Palestinian refugees are waiting the chance to reach Europe escaping the ongoing war in Syria and to end the suffering of their displacement in the Syria surrounding countries through all ways including sea.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 20\08\2016

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- 8000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Turkey
- 1000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Gaza
- More than 79,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till mid 2016
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1160 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1220 days, water was cut for 709 days respectively. The number of siege victims is 187.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 1012 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1203 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 863 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
