Statistics

On the eve of the Children's World Day, the monitoring and documenting team in AGPS confirmed that they had documented 182 victims from the Palestinian children who were killed in Syria as well as AGPS said that the real number is much more than this in which the number is expected to be doubled twice at least because of the various difficulties experienced by the Group in monitoring the ages of victims which are often linked to the security situation in the places of their deaths especially for victims of shelling and explosions.

It is worth mentioning that the AGPS documented number until today is (3064) victims of refugees because of the war in Syria for various reasons; most notably bombing, clashes, and death under torture in the Syrian regime's prisons in addition to the siege imposed on the Yarmouk camp in which (184) refugees died as a result of food medical care shortages.





Recent Updates

Websites of the Syrian Opposition reported that an operation targeted the Lieutenant at the PLA Tareq Al Khadra, where a bomb targeted his convoy near Al Mara'a neighborhood in Damascus. The Sources added that the targeting of Tareq came as a response on the participation of the PLA in fighting beside the Syrian regime forces. AGPS was not able to make sure of the reported news from another source, where no press statements were issued by the PLA till the preparation of this report.

In a different context, the Syrian warplanes targeted the adjacent farms of Khan Al Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus suburb with two raids. A tension and fear state prevailed amongst the residents who suffer from targeting their camp with explosive barrels and mortar shells, which led to victims and wounded people and destruction of houses and properties , coincided with confrontations between the Opposition and the Popular committees alongside the Regular Army.

It is noted that the Regular Army is still closing all roads that connect the camp with the Damascus the capital, which force the residents to go through Zakia-Khan Al Sheih dangerous road to reach Damascus.

In Damascus, the Emergency Medical Services Team in the National Committee for Palestinians of Syria Relief inside the Yarmouk camp in Cooperation with the PRCS evacuated two ladies on 19 November 2015, they are; Nabela Khalil Khattab , who was born in 1966, had a brain bleeding caused hemiplegia and the elder Wasfeyya Awad Mefleh, who was born in 1942, in order to get treatment at Yafa hospital in Damascus.



The remaining 3 to 5 thousands residents of Yarmouk camp still suffer from severe shortage in the medical services due to the continuation of the strict siege imposed by the Regular Army and the PFGC that prevents the entry of medicine and drugs needed for the diseases but very few and for long periods, where the toll of the siege



victims raised to 184 victims died due to hunger and lack of medical care.

On the other hand, the residents of AL Sayeda Zainab camp in Damascus Suburb and Al Nairab camp in Aleppo organized yesterday solidarity marches to support Al Masjed Al Aqsa Al Mubarak in all of the two camp's streets. 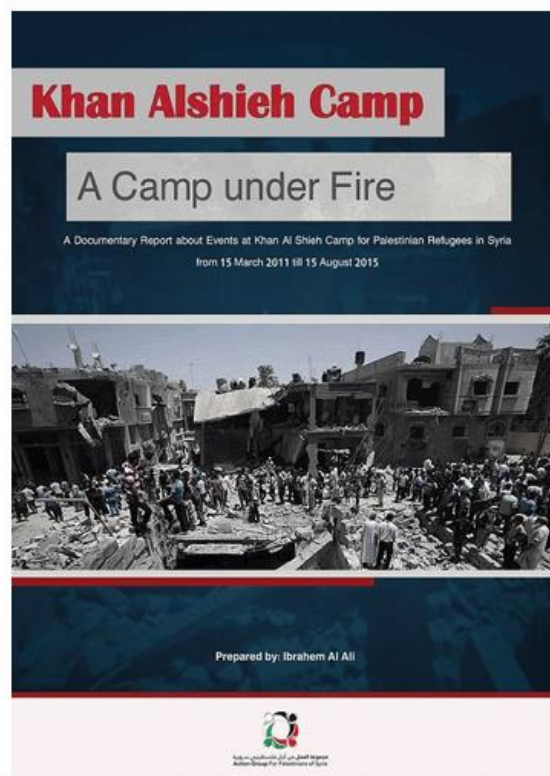

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria (AGPS)

AGPS issued the English version of, "Khan Al-Sheeh ... A camp under fire" report. The report documents events witnessed in Khan Al-Sheeh camp for Palestinian refugees, in the west of the city of Damascus, in the light of the Syrian crisis as well as the violence and the revolutionary mobility since March 2011, until 15 August, 2015. The report depends mainly on field documentation done by AGPS through their correspondents in the camp in addition to a number of eyewitnesses from the residents of Khan Al- Sheeh camp.



The report is extremely cautious in providing the necessary information regarding the field and humanitarian conditions of Khan



Al- Sheeh camp in addition to the changes that took place in an important stage in the history of the camp specifically entering to the core of the conflict in Syria.

It is noteworthy that "Khan Al- Sheeh camp is under fire" report is part of a documentary series of reports issued by AGPS for the conditions of the Palestinians of Syria.

Numbers and Statistics till 19/11/2015:-

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: – Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 872 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 942 days, water was cut for 432 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 184 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: – Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 733 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: – Residents have left the camp for 934 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.

- Dara'a Camp: – It is now almost 578 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: – A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: – Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia– Khan Al Shieh road.
