Recent Updates

After being waited for a full day on the Lebanese Syrian borders, Lebanese General Security allows the six Palestinian Syrian mothers to join their children in Lebanon, after they insist to enter Lebanon. The six mothers had to wait for 24 hours before the Lebanese General Security allows them to enter Lebanon, while the mothers were accompanied their children in Syria to do the official exams there.

It is noteworthy that Lebanon has taken several decisions against the Palestinian Syrian refugees, as they put strict conditions on their entry into Lebanon, in addition to not renewing the residencies for refugees inside Lebanon.

On the other hand, clashes broke out in Alnairab camp at Aleppo, between members of the Popular Committees affiliated with the Syrian Army, following a dispute between them, where they began to exchange fire, and then one of them threw a bomb. The reports talk about a number of casualties.

It is noteworthy that Neirab camp under the full control of the Regular Army and some Palestinian factions loyal to it, the camp is considered a gate to the Regular Army because the military and the international airport.

Sounds of bombings were heard in Khan Al Shieh camp that rocked the camp. The sounds appeared to be bombings on the surrounding areas. The camp and the surrounding areas are witnessing a much tensed security situation because of the repeated clashes and bombings. On the living aspect, the camp is suffering of a severe shortage of medical services where all hospitals and clinics have been stopped except an UNRWA clinic. The clinic works in its minimum capacity because of the roads cut between the camp and the surrounding areas.

The siege continues on the Yarmouk refugee camp in Damascus city a year ago. The remaining people are suffering of a severe shortage in food items and medical services where 150 people died due to the hunger and shortage of medical care, according to the Action Group statistics. It is worth mentioning that all hospitals have been stopped but the Palestine hospital that works with its minimum capacity.
