
"Activists Launch an Electronic Campaign Demanding to Rescue the Refugee Ahmed Omar who is injured and Stuck in Slovenia"

Victims

The Palestinian refugee Ammar Abu Eid died due to torture in the Syrian prisons; he was being arrested since the end of 2012 for distributing bread for free to the displaced people in Barza Shelter Center in Damascus. It is referred that Ammar's Grandfather is one of October War martyrs in 1973. It is mentioned that AGPS



documented 417 death cases due to torture from the Palestinian refugees who were detained in the Syrian Security prisons.

Recent Updates

Palestinian Activists launched yesterday an electronic campaign to call the ICRC and Doctors without Borders organizations to immediately interfere to save the Palestinian Syrian Refugee Ahmed Omar who is injured and stuck in Slovenia.

It is mentioned that Ahmed Omar was injured due to bombing on Yarmouk camp in Damascus which led to suffer paraplegia in lower extremities. Omar moved from Turkey to Greece through sea and he is now stuck in Slovenia and needs treatment and medical care. The Activists stressed in their campaign that they launched through Avaaz network for Social Campaigns on the necessity for all organizations and human rights organizations to act now to help the refugee Ahmed Omar.

Syria

The Palestinian child Waleed Mohanned Salem from Al Aedin camp was injured in his head after firing shootings from the south side of the camp by the Syrian Regime forces centered near the University housing the day before. The bullet entered his back part of head and because of the weak capacities and the bad situation of the child, Bisan hospital administration apologized to receive him as well as Al-Ameen Hospital administration refused to receive the case in which the taxi that carries him reached to Al-Razi Hospital and that there will not be any medical intervention before the passage of 72 hours on the case mentioning that the child Waleed is eight-year-old, from the village of Umm Al-Faraj in Palestine.

It is noteworthy that the AlAedin camp in Homs suffers from large harassment and continuous targeting by the Syrian army and security forces in which made its residents to call the camp Al Aedin prison.



On the other hand, farms and western parties of Khan Al- Sheih camp for Palestinian refugees Damascus Suburb was exposed to intermittent artillery.

This comes in light of continuing the closure of roads by the regular that connect the camp with Damascus suburb forcing the residents to take (Zakya – Khan Al- Sheih) road despite the risk that they may be exposed to after repeated targeting of this road.

Europe

Palestinian refugee "Abdullah Moussa" won the first prize of Judo Championship at the Kingdom of Sweden level in which he had arrived in the Kingdom of Sweden after the war forced him to migrate from the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus to the north of Europe. It is worth mentioning that the Kingdom of Sweden is the first destination for thousands of Palestinians escaping form the war in Syria looking for safety and escaping from the shelling and siege.





In a different context, the Italian Foreign Ministry announced hosting five sick children of Palestinian refugees from the residents of the Yarmouk camp in Syria for treatment and the Foreign Ministry said in a press release the day before yesterday that the five children are suffering from serious and chronic diseases and will be treated in Italian hospitals. In addition, it stressed that the five children and their families are currently in Rome city in the specialized hospitals and receiving the medical procedures for their treatment while the Italian Ministry of Health pledged to provide material support and all the expenses of treatment of the five children traveling with their parents and stay in Italy.

Italian Foreign Ministry added that there was a cooperation between the ministry of health and Defense in Italy, the Embassy of Italy in Lebanon, UNRWA, and the Italian institution 'Kim' to bring up five children from Syria to Lebanon then to Italy by an Italian military plane.

Numbers and Statistics till 20/9/2015

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.
- The Yarmouk Camp: Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 810 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 880 days, water was cut for 370 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 672 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: Residents have left the camp for 873 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 517 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jarmana, AL SaiedaZainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.
