RECENT UPDATES

Family of the refugee "Hanan Hassan Moussa" who was shot dead with a group of Palestinian-Syrian refugees while trying to reach the Turkish

territory, last Wednesday 17 February 2016, appealed to the International Committee of Red Cross ICRC, to intervene and release the bodies of the victims from the hospitals of south of Turkey.



According to the family of "Hanan" who contacted the AGPS; each one of "Hanan

Hassan Moussa," and "Amena Yosef" and "Imad Azzouz" residents of Al-Sayeda Zeinab camp has been shot by Turkish border guards while trying to cross the borders, where the victim was trying to reunite with her daughters in Germany.

The family confirmed that the bodies are still in a morgue in a hospital south of Turkey, and appealed to the Red Cross to work on the repatriation of them to Syria to be buried in the cemetery of Al-Sayida Zaynab camp in Damascus Countryside.

A few days ago the AGPS reported the incident, but at the time "Maram Marwan Mohammed" was the only known victim, she was accompanied by others shot dead while trying to enter Turkish territory from an area controlled by Kurdish groups.

In another context, the only road for Khan Eshieh Palestinian refugees Camp in Damascus Suburb was targeted, yesterday morning, by heavy

machine guns what led to a state of tension among civilians who were at Zakya - Khan Eshieh Road, it is noteworthy that this road has been targeted continuously by Shelka vehicles stationed around, in spite of this, people are forced to risk and cross it because it is the only way remaining after the regime's army closed all other roads linking the camp to the center of capital Damascus.



On another hand, Syrian Security released the Palestinian refugee "Firas Muteb Alramly" after an arrest that lasted about a month, he is one of the residents of Khan Eshieh camp in Damascus Suburb. Solders of Alkutafeh checkpoint of the Syrian security arrested "Alramly" while going to work.

Action group has documented 1052 Palestinian prisoners in Syrian jails since the beginning of the war in Syria, including 106 detainees from Khan Eshieh camp still unaccounted for.

Relief and Works Agency of Palestinian refugees UNRWA announced receiving financial support worth \$47.7 Million Dollars from the United States, in favor of Palestinian refugees in Syria.

"UNRWA" announced in a statement posted on its website, that \$37.5 Million of the donation, will be allocated to support the emergency response activities of the Agency in Syria, where "The estimated number of Palestinian refugees who are still living there is about 450 thousand refugees".


The International Agency explained that more than 60 percent of the Palestinian refugees in Syria have become displaced within Syria, its estimated that about 95 percent of them depend on UNRWA's humanitarian aid.

it pointed out that it will allocate \$10.2 Million for what it called as "emergency interventions" of the Agency in Lebanon and Jordan, noting that "the vast majority of Palestine refugees from Syria who are in Lebanon and Jordan live a precarious and marginalized existence and unable to regulate their legal status or access to civil registration procedures and basic social services".

"UNRWA" states that it is seeking to obtain \$414 million in order to meet the minimum humanitarian needs of the Palestine refugees affected by the conflict in Syria during 2016.

In a different topic, monitoring and documentation team in the Action group for the Palestinians of Syria AGPS announced that the number of Palestinian refugees who were killed in the province of Daraa southern Syria since the beginning of the war in Syria is 334 victims at least, including 230 of the residents of Daraa camp, and 45 of residents Al Muzeireeb, while 59 others were killed in different parts of Daraa

(Albalad, Assad road, Tafas, Naemeh, Ataman, Azraa', Jassem, Almaziraa', Gillien, the countryside of Daraa, Tassel, and Tal Shihab).

Action group revealed that the reasons behind the death of the "334" victims as follows: (170) by shelling, (37) by a sniper shots, (67) by shots and clashes, (3) under torture, while (20) refugees were executed, (15) under torture in the Syrian regime's prisons, (10) refugees died for unknown reasons, (10) others as a result of a car bomb, a man died as a result of inadequate medical care, and another burned to death, 2 by knives, a refugees died after being kidnapped and killed, and a refugees shot dead by the Zionist occupation.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 21 February 2016

- 15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 42,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 981 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1043 days, water cut for 531 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.

- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 837 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1030 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 691 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-SaiedaZainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.
