Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent reported that a horrible voice of explosion rocked Al Muzareeb town in Der'aa yesterday, which injured two people and resulted in material damages in houses and properties, as it spread panic state amongst the residents. The explosion resulted from a bomb that targeted a leader in one of the Opposition military groups.



A worry state prevailed among the residents of Al Muzareeb town, which inhabited with more than 8500 Palestinian refugees, due to the continuation of the assassination attempts and planting bombs. A resident describe the situation as a threat because they don't know the doer or the people who are behind explosions under the security chaos which is spread in the whole area.

Activists accused the Syrian Security of those assassinations and bombs in the Opposition controlled areas where some others said that may be it was by the same Brigade as eliminations inside the brigades, but other activists accuse foreign intelligence, which is active in those areas. It is

mentioned that the AGPS documented about 339 victims from the Palestinians of Syria refugees in Der'aa governorate south of Syria since the beginning of the ongoing war, including 46 victims from Al Muzareeb.

In Damascus eastern Suburb, the Syrian warplanes targeted the farms and towns near Khan Al Shieh camp with a number of explosive barrels

at Skaik vicinity, Al Reda Street, and Al Abaseyya farms which spread panic among the residents specially women and children. The Syrian Regime continues to target Zakia-Khan Al Shieh road, which is the only road for the residents to get bread, vegetables, and fuel that



is negatively affected by the closure of the road because it is the only road for 2000 families in the camp. The targeting of Zakia road doubled the suffering of the residents in the camp because of the roads closure between the camp and the city center.

In Aleppo Suburb, the suffering of the Palestinian refugees, who were displaced from Handarat camp, continues since 1089 days respectively due to the control of the military Syrian Opposition over the camp, where the residents face difficult living situation, in addition to the high prices and the unavailability of the material resources. Handarat camp and the surrounding areas are still exposed to bombing and violent clashes between the Opposition armed groups and the Regular Army alongside Al

Quds Brigade, where the Regular Army tries to control the camp, which forms a strategic point for the Army, and the Opposition is also trying to control the camp to go towards Handarat town and Aleppo Central Prison. AGPS documented the names of 43 victims from Handarat camp and also documented 32 detainees in the Syrian prisons.

Statistics

The AGPS Documentation and Monitoring team documented 81 Palestinian Syrian refugees died out of Syria; 15 died in Egypt, 12 died in Lebanon, 17 died in Libya, 8 died in Greece, 12 in Turkey, 6 in Malta, 3 in Palestine, 3 in Italy, a refugee in Sweden, a refugee in Cyprus, a refugee in Macedonia, and 2 victims died in Germany.

It is mentioned that the number of Palestinians of Syria who died has reached 3212 Palestinian victims, according the statistics of AGPS, where the victims died due to direct reasons like bombing, clashes and torture in the prisons and siege and due to indirect reasons like drowning while trying to reach Europe through the so called Death Boats.

Netherland

The Palestinian organizations in Netherland and the Dutch organization, which are advocating for the cause of Palestine, in partnership with the Palestine House organization organized a solidarity set-in with the Palestinian camps in Syria and Yarmouk camp in Particular, which is

exposed to cruel living situation due to siege by Syrian Regime and its Palestinian factions since more than 1041 days respectively. The earlier violent clashes between ISIS and Al Nusra increased the suffering of the remaining residents.

It is mentioned that the set-in was carried out yesterday in front of the Dutch parliament in Hague. The participants raised the Palestine flags and chanted for Yarmouk and its residents; the set-in also includes a theatre show to shed light on the suffering of the Yarmouk residents in Syria.



Civil Work Committees

The Palestine Charity Commission for the Relief of the Palestinian People distributed, within its project, which is titled as "Our Families, Our Responsibility", food parcels to the Palestinian refugees in Al Husseneia camp and Kherbet AL Sheyab in Damascus Suburb. It is worthy to mention that dozens of Palestinian families have left their camps after being targeted by the Syrian Regime to Al Sherba area

specially Al Husseneia camp, which is controlled by the Syrian Regular Army that prevents the residents to return back since 895 days respectively, Yarmouk camp, and Al Theyayba area.

Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics till 21\04\2016:

- 15500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Jordan
- 42.500 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Lebanon
- 6000 Palestinian Syrian refugees are in Egypt, according to the UNRWA statistics till July 2015
- More than 71.2 thousand Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the End of December 2015
- The Yarmouk Camp: siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC groups, continued for 1041 consecutive days. Power cut continued for more than 1101 days, water was cut for 591days respectively. The number of siege victims is 186.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 896 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp: All Residents have left the camp for about 1089 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: It is now almost 749 days without water and almost 70% of its buildings were demolished.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Sheih road.
