"ISIS in Yarmouk Camp Informs its Members and Civilians of Migration from the Area"

Recent Updates

The AGPS correspondent south of Damascus reported that ISIS in the Yarmouk camp informed its fighters, through wireless devices, that "immigration is obligatory" about their exit from the region. The correspondent pointed out that ISIS in the southern region of Damascus, informed its members that the first batch of them will be out in the next few days to areas of their control east of Syria.



Meanwhile, some fighters started to sell their property in areas under their control. Witnesses confirmed that some of the fighters offered their motorcycles for sale at low prices in the market of Orouba south of Yarmouk camp, and some of them packed their bags, according to some residents. The AGPS received one of ISIS posters that was placed in the Yarmouk refugee camp; the poster calls on people wishing to leave the area to register their names in three media points determined by the ads, one of them near Palestine mosque, the second one is at Orouba Street, and the third one is at Al- Asali area.

In the meantime, our correspondent north of Syria reported that the Syrian regime began to include the members of the pro-regime



"Jerusalem Brigade in his battles against ISIS in the areas of Deir al-Azur and Tadmor. Eyewitnesses from al-Nairab camp in Aleppo reported that a number of vehicles, along with dozens of Jerusalem Brigade members, including Palestinian refugees, moved from the camp to the areas of Tadmor and Deir al-Zour.

Activists in the al-Nairib camp accused the regime of sending their sons to Deir al-Zour and Tadmur camps, where the coalition forces intensively bombarding ISIS lairs, and putting them in a battle that is not their battle, calling the Palestinian fighters not to participate.

The Syrian regime continues to detain the Palestinian refugee, "Tariq al-Saleh" for the fifth year without knowing his fate. He was arrested at a Syrian checkpoint in the city of Idlib northern Syria. No information has been received about him, and he is from Idlib city. His family and friends appealed to anyone who had information or was able to see him inside Syrian prisons to communicate with the "Action Group".



In the United States of America, the Palestinian refugee, "Reham Isam Alkusi", from the Yarmouk camp, and originally from the town of Al-



Ja'unah in Palestine, received her MSc in Politics and International Affairs from Columbia University in New York, USA, after she obtained the second level for her graduation project.

In Lebanon, Al Khairiah for the Relief of the Palestinian people, in cooperation with Alirshad wal Islah community, distributed financial aid for the Palestinian Syrian children who were displaced at Wdi Alzina area at Kharoub region south of Lebanon. 1800 child benefited from the aid which included cloths, blankets, and gift. The aid came within some charity projects for the displaced Palestinian Syrian refugees, and who are living in Wadi Alzina area.



Palestinians of Syria; Numbers and Statistics until 21\05\2017

- *The AGPS documented 3501 Palestinian victims, including 461 women.*
- *1603 Palestinians are detained in the Syrian regime intelligence and security branches, including 99 women.*
- *The Regular Army and the PF-GC groups are besieging the Yarmouk camp for 1402 consecutive days.*

- *196 male and female Palestinian refugees died due to the lack of nutrition and medical care because of the siege; most of them are from the Yarmouk Camp.*
- *It is now more than 1133 days without water in Deraa camp, and 984 days in the Yarmouk camp.*
- *Residents of Handarat camp are prevented from returning to their houses for 1477 days, while the camp is controlled by the Regular Army for more than 211 days.*
- *Almost 85,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe till the end of 2016, while the number of Palestinian refugees in Lebanon is almost 31,000, in Jordan 17,000, in Egypt 6000, in Turkey 8000, and in Gaza 1000.*
