Victims

The action Group documented that 224 victims died due to torture in the Syrian Regime prisons till yesterday. The severe torture leads to the death of the detainees in the Syrian Security branches. During its following up of the victims, the Action Group documented four new victims died under torture including the two brothers Ali and Hasan Abu Al Enin, they are twins from the Yarmouk camp who were born in 1994, They were arrested near Al Hujira checkpoint.

The action Group also documented the death of Tarek Yaser Rashdan from the Yarmouk camp 29 years old and France Al Daeef from Al Aedin camp at Homs during their arrest in the Syrian Security prisons.

Recent Updates

The warplanes targeted Handarat camp in Aleppo in a number of explosive barrels coincided with the broke out of violent clashes in the camp between the Syrian opposition groups and the Syrian Army. It is mentioned that many houses were completely destroyed due to the frequent and violent bombing. The opposition groups fully control the Handarat camp after violent clashes that forced the resident to leave to the surrounding cities and camps.

Explosive barrels targeting Handarat camp

In Damascus city a victim was killed and a number of wounded from Khan Al Shaih camp in Damascus city, due to targeting the bus which was transporting them to the camp through Zakia road, where their bus was hit by bullets and shells. The targeting led to the killing of Montaha Qassem Abdu, moreover, three women were injured and a number of men. It is mentioned that Zakia road is the only road for the residents of the camp to reach the surrounding areas, the residents live in a worry and tension state due to the frequent targeting of the camp and its vicinity.

In the Yarmouk camp in Damascus, the checkpoints of the regular army and groups from the PFGC, Which are imposing a strict siege on the Yarmouk cam since more that 400 days, allowed the entry of a limited amounts of food aids to be distributed on the Yarmouk residents. People were gathered since the early morning in the Reeja square in the middle of the Main Yarmouk Street hoping to get a food basket to alleviate the siege impacts.


The Yarmouk residents suffer of a severe shortage of medical care in addition to the stop of all of its bakeries and the running out of food materials from its markets. The Yarmouk camp witnessed yesterday the visit of some people from Al Qadam and the visitors were allowed to stay there just for three hours. It is referred that the surrounding areas had
