RECENT UPDATES

On the occasion of the fifth anniversary of Syrian uprising, the Palestinian Return Centre in London, in cooperation with the Scottish National Party's friends of Palestine Committee, have organized a seminar in the British House of Commons about the Palestinians of Syria issue.

The seminar has been hosted and chaired by the MP Tommy Sheppard, member of Parliament and the SNP, and attended by seven other MPs including the Baroness Jenny Tonge.

During the seminar, Cathryn Ramsay from Amnesty International presented part of the agency's report about violations committed against Palestinian women in Lebanon.



While Anne Irfan from Medical Aid for Palestine said that Palestinian refugees are suffering in both the countries hosting them and the international agencies that do not treat them equally with their Syrian counterparts.

The Polish human rights activist Magda Qandil said the conditions inside the Palestinian camps of Syria are still deteriorated because of the ongoing war, adding that there is sort of neglect by the UNRWA which dropped the Al-Yarmouk camp from the besieged areas list despite not lifting the siege.

Sameh Habib, head of Media and PR in the PRC stressed the need for improving living circumstances of Palestinian refugees in the hosting countries, point to the importance of European Countries to provide support for them.

Habib assured that the Israeli occupation is responsible for the Palestinians' suffer, indicated that the solution is to let them return back to their houses and villages they were forced to leave upon the 1948 war.

It is noteworthy that this seminar was held in conjunction with another event in the United Nations Headquarters in Geneva on the sideline of the 31 regular session of Human Rights Council, where the PRC has presented a verbal statement on the same issue as well.

On another topic, the AGPS' correspondent reported a state of tension and anxiety prevailed in Al-Muzireeb town south of Syria following the clashes between the opposition's forces on the one hand and members of ISIL and other drug dealers on the second hand, the



clashes resulted in many victims and injuries.

Other news talked about the execution of brothers "Bilal and Ahmad Orab" by the opposition's forces who accused them of drug dealing, according to local activists.

These incidents come after an explosive device hit the town two days ago without identifying the doer.

NGOs

The Palestine Charity Association has finished the second phase of its project aiming to turn the place of UNRWA's destroyed school into a football field, the project started on 29 January 2016 on the ground of UNRWA's school that had been completely destroyed by explosive barrels dropped by the Syrian warplanes.

This initiative comes as part of the association's programs of civil service, in light of complete absence of Municipality and all other governmental services.

It is noteworthy that the school is located inside the old camp, and was used as an alternative school before it was destroyed last year.

STATISTICS

The Monitoring and documentation team of the AGPS has announced that 59 Palestinian victims were killed during February month, 12% of them were children, 39 of them were killed in the bombardment that hit Al-Sayyida Zaynab Camp on 21 February 2016, 11 others were shot dead, 4 were tortured to death in the regime's prisons, 4 killed by shelling and 1 by sniper shot.

The AGPS assured that those victims belong to the Syrian Cities as follows: 48 to Damascus Countryside, 4 to Damascus, 3 to Daraa, 2 to Aleppo and 1 to Lattakia.

Palestinians of Syria in numbers and statistics Until 22 March 2016

- 15,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan,
- 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.
- More than 71,200 Palestinian Syrian refugees have arrived Europe until the end of December 2015.
- The Yarmouk Camp: still under siege imposed by the Syrian Regime's Army and PFLP-GC (Popular Front for the Liberation of Palestine General Command), continued for 1011 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 1072 days, water cut for 560 days. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 186 victims.
- Al Sbeina Camp: Syrian Regime's Army still preventing the residents from returning back to their houses for 867 days respectively.

- Handarat Camp: All of its residents have left the camp for 1058 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.
- Dara'a Camp: Running water cut continues for 721 days, and 70% of its buildings were destroyed.
- Jarmana, AL-Saieda Zainab, Al-Raml, Al-Aedein Homs and Al-AedeinHama: A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.
- Khan Al-Sheih Camp: Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia-Khan EShieh road.
