"More than 260 Palestinian Syrian Families in Gaza Demand the PLO to Take Responsibility towards them"

Recent Updates

On the sidelines of a panel discussion organized by the Palestinian NGO Network in Gaza, more than "260" Palestinian Syrian family in Gaza demanded Refugee Affairs Department of the PLO to shoulder their responsibilities towards them, especially with regard to its role to provide adequate housing for them, stable source of income to provide a decent life, and free university education.

They also demanded the Minister of Social Affairs to form a committee to deal with this file and ensure their inclusion in the Palestinian society and their access to the national number, it is referred that the number of Palestinian refugees who fled from the hell of war in Syria and returned to the Gaza Strip is estimated at about 1,000 people, according to the Ministry of Social Affairs, UNRWA, and the PLO Palestinian.

In Syria, violent clashes broke out in the vicinity of Handarat camp in Aleppo between the Regular Army and groups of the Syrian opposition, where the Regular Army continues to try, supported by members of what is known as the Al Quds Brigade, which includes a number of Palestinians, to control the camp and the adjacent road. It is noteworthy that the Syrian opposition had seized fully control of the camp since about "545" days after violent clashes forced most of the camp's residents to flee.

In a related context, the road between Al Nairab Camp and Aleppo center is still closed for the fifth day respectively and the impact of the continuing sniping who from the point of Ameria, prompting the forces of the regular army to open a road that runs from inside the artillery school in Ramouseh area. Therefore, the regular army seeks to re-open the road of what constitutes the importance as it linking Aleppo with AL Nairab Airport, and the rest of the Syrian governorates.

On the other hand, the water cuts in the Yarmouk camp in Damascus for 44 days amid fears of the spread of diseases and epidemics among people, while the siege imposed by the regular army and groups of the PFGC is still continue for 474 days respectively. The siege has led to the suspension of all health facilities with the exception of Palestine hospital, which works with its minimum capacity due to the acute shortage of cadres and medical materials.

As in Lebanon, the activist "Ali Huwaydi" confirmed that the Lebanese government to take measures that would reduce the number of Palestinian and Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and impose severe restrictions on the admission of any other refugees in its territory. Huwaydi said in an interview with the newspaper "Palestine" that there is a formal decision to reduce the numbers of refugees, and the tightening of restrictions on the entry of any Palestinian refugees to Lebanon, and not to accept them in its territory, except in very exceptional circumstances. He also noted that the number of Palestinian refugees displaced from Syria to Lebanon ranges between 44-45 thousand Palestinian refugees.


He explained that the living conditions and the economic and social situation of the refugees is very difficult, and more difficult with the approaching of winter, pointing out that the winter is one of the most seasons of the year that highlight the problems of refugees, especially relating to food, adequate housing and adequate clothing.

Meanwhile, the committee of displaced Palestinians coming from Syria to Lebanon performed a sit-in at AL Borj Al Shamali camp in front of the UNRWA Director Office, condemning and rejecting the arbitrary UNRWA decision of cutting aid to more than 1,100 displaced families from Syria, where UNRWA had taken this decision earlier to cut off aid to more than a thousand Palestinian Syrian family in Lebanon.

The Palestinian Camps in Syria, Numbers and Statistics:

- The Yarmouk Camp: The Continuance of the siege by the Regular Army and PFGC for the 474 respectively in addition to the power cut for more than 557 days and the water cut for 44 days respectively. The number of the siege victims is 155 victims.
- Al Husayneyya Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 376 days respectively.

- Al Sheina Camp: The Regular Army still prevents the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for the 345 days respectively.
- Handarat Camp:-The residents left the camp since 545 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled the camp.
- Dara'a Camp: Almost 191 days without water and a complete absence of basic services.are still closed except for the Zakia road.
- Khan Danoun Camp: economic crises continue, specially the unemployment and the high prices.
- Al Nairab Camp: the power is still cut for more than a year, and the road that link the camp with Aleppo is still closed for the fifth days respectively.
- Jermana, AL Saieda ZAinab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: relative calm situation in light of the economic crises.
