Torture Victims

The AGPS documented the death of many brothers during the Syrian Crises in the prisons of the Syrian regime; some of them were recognized through the leaked photos of torture victims, while other victims were announced to be dead by their families after being informed by the Syrian security; the victims are:

- *The three brothers Amer, Umar, and Sameer Hamdan, from the Yarmouk camp, and died on 28-04-2014.*
- *The three sisters Heyam, Ahlam, and Amal Saad Al-Dein, from Al Raml camp, and died on 30-03-2015.*
- *The two brothers Nidal and Yamed Jihad Saadeia, from the Yarmouk camp, and died on 17-05-2013.*
- *The two brothers Ahmed and Mohammed Abdullah, from the Yarmouk camp, and died on 04.28.2014.*
- *The two sisters Baraa' and Aya Abdullah, from Damascus suburb, and died on 20.03.2015.*



- *The two brothers Adhamand Bilal Al-Hassan, from Damascus, and died on 13.04.2015.*



- The two brothers Shaher and Tayseer Fadil Shahada died on 10.08.2014.
- The two brothers Mohammed and Mahmoud Abdel-Hafiz, from Damascus- Domr area, and died on 22.01.2014.
- The young man Ihsan Abu Rashid died on 12/05/2015 and younger sister Islam Abu Rashid died on 13/03/2015.

The AGPS documented the names of 421 victims of Palestinian refugees who died due to torture in Syrian prisons, as well as several cases of families and siblings who are still detainees in Syrian prisons cellars, while the group has documented the names of 988 Palestinian prisoners during the ongoing war in Syria.

Recent Update

A medical body in the Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees in Damascus announces the complete running out of medical supplies and medicines from the besieged camp, warning the suspension on of first aid services in less than a week.

"Rescue Medical Center" in the Yarmouk refugee camp announced through a statement described as important, running out of all medical disposables and ambulatory and anesthesia medicines, noting that fuel needed to run generators almost complete ran out, warning the stoppage of working in less than a week.





The medical situation in the besieged camp since more than (843) days by the regular army and PFGC groups has aggravated after ISIS storming and controlling over the camp since the beginning of last April, where ISIS assassinated a number of relief activists inside the camp, prompting most relief agencies inside the camp to leave, fearing for their staff of murder.

A number of fuel robbery cases by ISIS were recorded, which dominated the camp with support and coordination of Nusra Front south of Damascus.

Turning to northern Syria, where the AGPS received confirmed information that the Syrian security forces arrested dozens of Palestinian refugees northern Syria while trying to reach Turkey during Eid al-Adha.

According to the information, there are a number of entire families were arrested; parents and their children, where the number of detainees was about 70 detainees, including women and children.

The sources confirmed the transfer of detainees to the military security prison in Hama before being transferred to Fayhaa Prison in Damascus, where they will be brought to trial, amid unconfirmed reports about the intention of the Syrian security prosecuted them under the pretext of illegal immigration.

It is worth mentioning that hundreds of Palestinian refugees fleeing from the war in Syria to Turkey by road, where they enter Turkey illegally, due to the Turkish authorities to prevent their entry under the pretext of not obtaining visas.



In the same context, raid and inspection campaign was launched in Al Aedein camp in Homs Against a number of houses by the Syrian security forces:

The house of "Shuaibi" family was raided on 18-10 morning on Jaffa Road, searching for weapons cache inside the house. The house is owned by Mr. Ahmed Shuaibi, who was executed by the Syrian security forces a few months ago.

The house of "Awad"family located in Al Quds Streetwas also raided inthe same day for the similar pretext.

The house of the refugee Mohammed Jumaa located in Jaffa Road was raided on 21-10morningin search of a family member.

In addition, the house of Bassam Khamis Aliwa on Jaffa Road was raided on the same day, in search of a family member.



Meanwhile, the Syrian security released the detained refugee Alaa Darwish who was arrested on (17 | 9 | 2015), in addition to the refugee "Khaled Jamal Zaid" known as Abu Jamal after being detained for four



months where he was arrested while traveling to Lebanon for an interview for family reunion in one of the European embassies.

UNRWA began distributing financial aid for the third session of 2015 for Palestinian refugees in Syria, starting from 18/10/2015 till 12/03/2015.

Each family member of the normal cases get an amount of 18,500 SP, and the families registered as difficult situation given 28000 SP per capita, as\ "UNRWA" to conduct the process of individual data auditing for Palestinian refugee living in Syria who did not take the previous session.



The agency said that the aim of this procedure is to make sure that all beneficiaries are present in Syria, and to update the data of families beneficiary from financial assistance in Syria, and that this process does not affect in any way the registration of Palestinian refugees or their situation in Syria.

It is noteworthy that the Palestinian refugees in Syria live in difficult and tragic situations in light of displacement, high prices, widespread unemployment, and rising house rent, in addition to arrests and casualties caused by the ongoing conflict.



In Lebanon, Lebanese sources reported news was quoted by the Lebanese army, the day before yesterday that a boat carrying migrants out of Lebanon was stopped, and according to sources, the boat was carrying 53 people, including 8 Lebanese, 28 Palestinians, 14 Syrians, and 3 others, while trying to smuggle out of Lebanon illegally.

It is worth mentioning that about 45,000 displaced Palestinian Syrians in Lebanon suffer from harsh living conditions, as well as unclear and volatile legal situation, especially with regard to the authorization of residence.

Numbers and Statistics till 22/10/2015

- *15,500 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Jordan, 45,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees in Lebanon, and 6,000 refugees in Egypt, according to the UNRWA's statistics till July 2015.*
- *At least 36,000 Palestinian Syrian refugees have reached Europe during the last 4 years.*
- *The Yarmouk Camp: - Siege, imposed by the Regular Army and PFGC, continued for 843 days respectively. In addition, power cuts continued for more than 913 days, water was cut for 403 days respectively. The number of victims due to the siege has reached to 182 victims.*
- *Al Sbeina Camp: - Regular Army is still preventing the residents of the camp to return back to their houses for 704 days respectively.*
- *Handarat Camp: - Residents have left the camp for 905 days after the Syrian Opposition Groups controlled it.*



- *Dara'a Camp: - It is now almost 549 days without water and 70% of its buildings were demolished.*
- *Jarmana, AL Saieda Zainab, Al Raml, Al Aedein Camps in Homs and Hamma: - A relatively quiet situation in light of the economic crises.*
- *Khan Al Sheih Camp: - Roads linking the camp to the city center are still closed except for Zakia- Khan Al Shieh road.*
