Daily report on the situation of Palestinian refugees in Syria



"Family of a Palestinian-Syrian child who disappeared in a sinking accident off the Greek shores launches an appeal"

- Deraa camp neighborhoods targeted with heavy machine guns
- Resident of Yarmouk camp disappears in Damascus
- Refugees protest on Greek islands against the slowness of procedures and poor living conditions



Latest Developments:

The family of the Palestinian-Syrian child "Hamza Hossam Abd Al-Qader Hamed" has called on the humanitarian organizations, the Red Cross and anyone who has information about their son to reveal his fate.

In their appeal on Facebook, the family stated that their son disappeared after their boat sank in the Aegean Sea off the Greek shores while immigrating from Turkey to Greece on 20/9/2015.



The family noted that their 8-year-old son Hamza has a speech disability. They had left Yarmouk camp for Palestinian refugees after it was attacked, immigrated to Turkey then fled to Europe.

In another context, clashes described as violent, broke out yesterday, between ISIS and the Syrian opposition factions in Yelda, after ISIS attempted to take the clinic point between Yelda and Yarmouk camp. According to AGPS's reporter that all types of light, medium and heavy weapons were used during the clashes that led to the death of a number of ISIS members. However, no news has



been confirmed regarding the presence of any casualties among the ranks of the armed Syrian opposition groups.

In south Syria, the regime forces targeted the neighborhoods in Deraa camp using heavy machine guns and mortar shells, yesterday. According to our correspondent, the bombardments did not cause any casualties among the civilians, however it led to material damage.

This comes amid the ongoing security tension in Deraa over the past few days, through which the camp was attacked several times with various types of weapons and mortars, leading to great destruction in its buildings.

In another context, Palestinian "Ahmed Sobhy Bekrawi" disappeared in the capital Damascus 4 days ago, after going out to work in a taxi on Thursday 19/10/2017.



His family said that they do not have any information about him and that his phone has been switched off since Thursday, calling on anyone who has information about him to call them. He is a resident of Yarmouk camp and lives on Street 15, west of the camp.



In Greece, dozens of refugees protested on Friday 20/10/2017 in Vial camp, in front of the European refugee office on the Greek Island of Chios, against the slowness of the immigration procedures and interviews which results in the slow transfer of refugees from the island to Greek mainland, in addition to the poor living conditions and lack of facilities inside the camp.

The Moria refugee camp on Lesbos Island saw a mass of refugees protesting to demand their release from the camp, the speeding up of their immigration procedures and the improvement of their tough living conditions. The protesters attempted to reach the Island's center, however the Greek Police prevented them.
