"Hundreds of Displaced people of Yarmouk Refugee Camp are Waiting the Return and the Implementation of the Initiative"

Victims

Ibrahim Aqel Hamdan is a Palestinian refugee who was killed affected by his wounds after a missile hit Karam Smadi neighborhood in Jaramana area at Damascus city.

Recent Updates

Hundreds of residents of the Yarmouk refugee camp, who were displaced, were gathered yesterday at the main entrance in order to return to their homes and properties. The gathering was just after signing the agreement of the Yarmouk camp neutralization amongst the Syrian authorities, represented by Head of Palestine Branch of intelligence, representative of Palestinian factions, brigades inside the camp and local and relief organizations.

The Yarmouk refugee camp witnessed a calm state accompanied with active movements for the people inside the camp who were trapped for 344 days respectively.

The Yarmouk camp people cleaned the streets and erased the sand mounds in the area that connects Lubya Street and Reeja square to receive the returning residents of the camp.

According to an activist, the Yarmouk people feel satisfied and comforted of the consequences of events though they live in constant anticipation to open the roads for entering food and the returning of life to its normal status.

Another relief activist expressed his pessimism towards the agreement and clarified" a similar agreement was signed before in 28th of November 2013 and was implemented in 10th of February 2014. Then, all armed members of the Free Army and the armed bridges evacuated their locations and went to the surrounding. Nothing of the agreement points was applied on ground because of accusing each other of the agreement failure"

In a related context, activists in Ya.rmouk expressed concern for the non-existence of any clear item in the last agreement of neutralize the camp, to ensures their personal safety and that they are not arrested during the implementation of the neutralization Agreement, as happened during the past agreements.

It is worth mentioning that there are hundreds of medical, relief, jurists and journalists activists who serve the trapped people inside Yarmouk refugee camp.

On the other hand, a number of humanitarian critical cases were directed, yesterday, from the camp to receive treatment in Jaffa hospital of Palestinian Red Crescent.

About the living situation, people of Yarmouk are still suffering from the running out of food and medicine and the continued power outages in all areas of the camp, a few months ago.

The Yarmouk agreement revived optimism and hope among the people of Husseiniya and Sbeina camps, who were forced to flee, because of the violent clashes that broke out between the Regular Army and groups of

the FSA, therefore, a number of activists and dignitaries called the PLO, Palestinian factions and the Syrian authorities to allow them to return to their homes and property, especially that the two camps are under the full control of the Regular Army few months ago.

In the meantime, the vicinity of Khan AL Sheih camp and adjacent farms were hit by explosive barrels, sparking a wave of discontent among people who suffer of stressful economic crises because of the continuing siege and the deterioration of the security situation in the areas adjacent to it.

In Jaramana camp, people are still living in a state of tension and instability as a result of security tensions in the areas surrounding them, and the targeting of Jaramana area with many mortar shills resulted in many wounded people. People of Jaramana camp are suffering of the lack of basic services, food materials, medicines and fuel.

Detainees

Action Group for Palestinians of Syria documented the detaining of six Palestinian refugees, including four brothers, by the Syrian Security, they are:

Ahmad, Zakaria, Mohammed and Yahya Hussein Jishi, from Kafarsouseh neighborhood in Damascus.

Mohammed Al Masri from Husseiniyeh camp, where he was detained for nearly a month by the Civil Committees in Jaramana camp.

Ali Amin Alian, 24 years, was arrested by members of the Regular Army at a checkpoint near the "town Center" in Aisha River at Damascus city, during his entry into Damascus coming from Daraa, accompanied by his parents; note that he is a state employee in Daraa.




